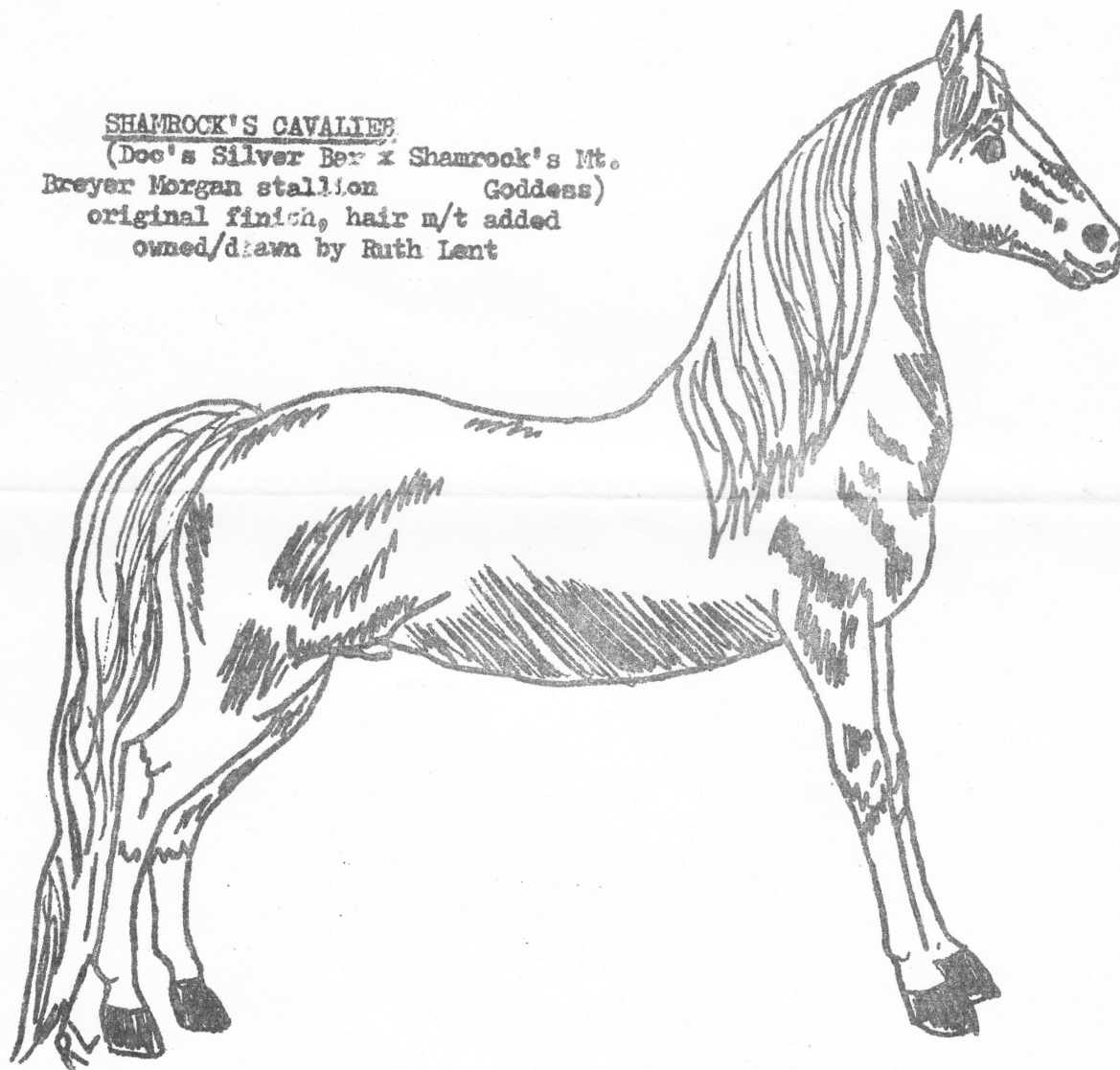

ANYTHING GOES...

Howdy! First, a note from last month's Anything Goes..it was SUE HOL BERG who sent in the neat poem about Pasos last time! Sorry about that, Sue! Now here's Cheryl Williams w/a write-up for this month: "I've just heard about what some TWH trainers do to their horses that's called "Soring." This is what a person w/a darranged & terrible mind does to walkers to make them pick his front feet up higher, & lean more of his weight to the rear of him. (TE-to get the desired look of 'high in the front, and tucked down in the back..eh?) The horse's front feet are either covered w/a liquid known as 'scooter juice' or chains or shackels are used to make the horse's feet sore! I think this process called SORING must be stopped!! If judges would go by the rules, I think this would help considerably, as the judges are the check for soring, and if there is, the horse is to be disqualified! Let's all try to stop soring, for ours & the horse's sakes!"

Yup, Cheryl, that goes on sometimes..there are always mean & terrible Walker trainers as there are trainers who race TB's too young for the money they'll win, only to cripple the horse before his time. The judges ARE supposed to check for Soring; but - w/the politics in the ring nowadays, many judges just pretend not to see the soring when they check the horses routinely at the line-up -I've seen it happen. So, unfortunately, until someone thinks of something else, and stops the POLITICS in the ring, there will always be some trainers who'll get by w/this cruel practice. Maybe soon somebody will think of something??!!

While I'm on the subject of mean & terrible things - some of you were under the impression that Saddlebred trainers Break their tails to set them - that the chains used hurt their feet, etc, etc. Well, I'd like to clear that up right now!! When a SB's tail is "Set," this is what they do...a skilled veterinarian simply severs 2 small muscles on each side of the tail-this prevents the horse from having so much strength to push his tail down hard between his legs, and his tail consequently goes up! He can still swish away flies, etc, etc, and the function of the tail is not hurt at all. The incision heals in about 10 days, and then the initial soreness from the surgery is gone. The REASON they set the tail, especially necessary when a horse is being trained into harness Like Muscles, is because when they get upset, they tend to push their tails down between their legs - slapping the driving line against their butts - which in turn, scares them to death & gets them twice as scared as they already are of their new training! In Muscle's case, this has been his ONLY problem - otherwise, Jim says, he's doing everything perfectly. And..if these muscles aren't cut, and the horse wears the 'tail set' (a harness-type leather contraption that holds the tail up all the time when he's not being worked,) he will push down against the tail set naturally, and get a big sore underneath his tail..kinda like bedsores, from pressure. If the horse isn't able to push against it hard, then he won't get sores. So, as I hope I've explained, it is not a crule procedure at all, and sure makes the horse look 100 times more like a Saddlebred than before! As for chains...they DO NOT hurt the horse's feet AT ALL...they simply make the horse react to them by picking up his feet more-which ALSO makes a big difference in a horse really "looking" like a SB. Some SB's really like to feel something around their feet, especially when they're racking (Rackin' chains) it kinda helps their rhythem, and the extra weight helps them to throw their feet higher & farther out. Weighted shoes don't hurt them, either...and weighted shoes are certainly not miracle workers...if the horse doesn't have the action, he won't have the action w/weighted shoes, either. All the shoes do is help the horse to use his legs MORE.

Sooo...hope I've cleared that up!! Thought while we were on the subject, I may as well tell you all just what they do, so there'd be no misunderstanding. And, I'm sure that even tho you may have known that setting tails wasn't cruel, you may have not known how they did it!
