ARABIAN STALLIONS

*FORTEL-(*Tear x *MB Martadah Baleh) My 1st Beswick! A very handsome fellow indeed! He's the 'Xayal' in a flashy palomino w/white, white m/t/blaze & 2 sox. I'm only showing him in halter & EP. I just bought an english saddle set for him & it really sets off his color. He has horses like Comet, Aza Destiny, Ferson, Synbad, "hask, "Witez, *Naborr, Sotep & Ofir on his Hom's side! Of course "Tsar speaks for himself. A low fee of 10¢ is all for this 22 yo.

*KASZTEL-(Ferseyn x Zgem) His color is WOW! A deep, deep glossy brown that you can see your reflection in. His black m/t & wt. blaze w/2 sox really sets that color off. He practically always places in the color classes. I'm showing him in halter & WP. His saddle is black, which matches his m/t & goes well w/his coat. Now for his credentials! He's 18 yo & has horses like Sotep, Enffles & Ferson in his pedigree! Really has a great thing going for himself! 10¢ fee.

*ZAIN-(Sinraf x *IB Martadah Belah) He's one of the rarer Beswick molds, the Arab horse on Potterry stand. He's 24 yr's old and definitely my favorite model. ARABIAN MARES

*COSMOSA-(*Tear x *Sarra) 3/4 sister to the well known *Czar! She has a style of her own, a high flashy trot that is bound to make her a winner. She'll be shown in halter & probably harness, though it's hard to say, I may show her also in park or dressage; she'd show well in any class! J. 
