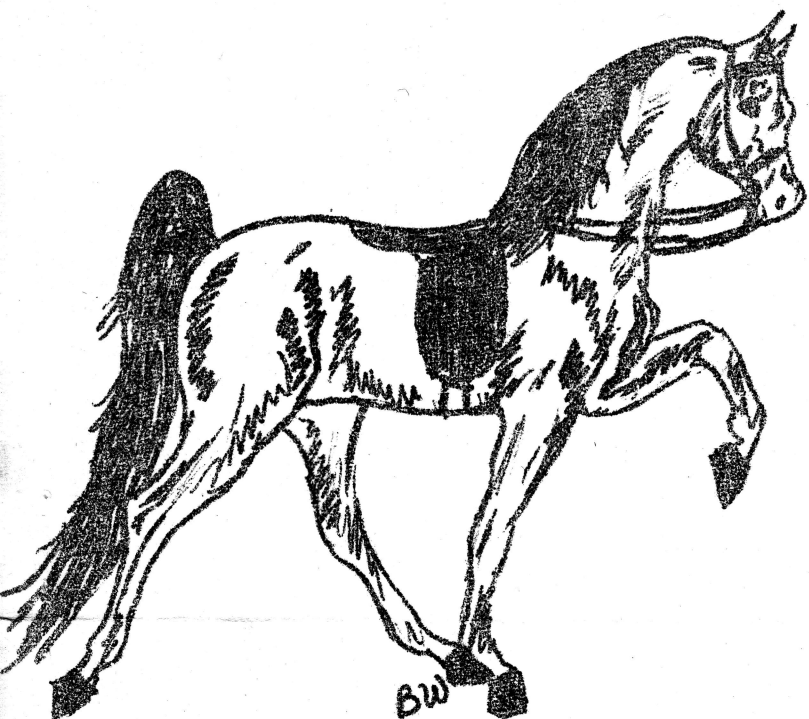


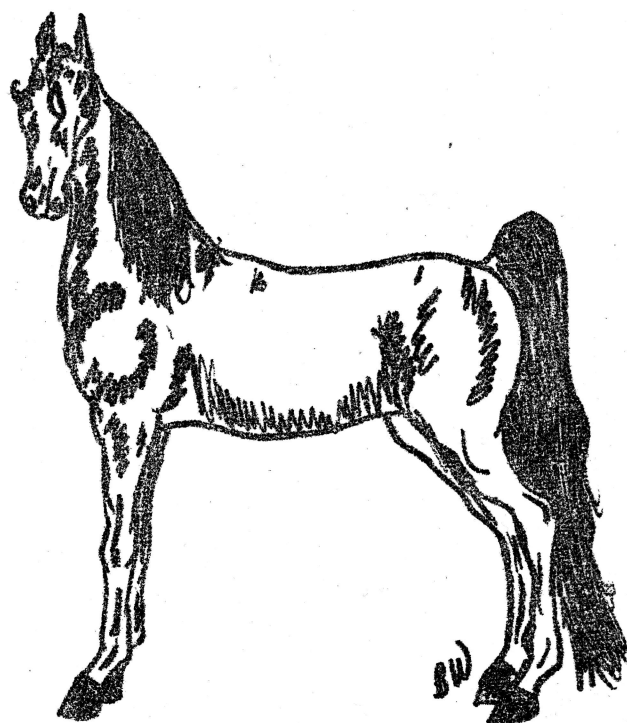

**RULES:** Starred classes: #26-Fox Hunt-outdoors! You find the fox, you get 1st place-there'll be 4 other animals hidden; the 1st person finding one of these gets 2nd place and on down to 5th. Open to all breeds of horses, especially those TB hunters!! (Your horse, of course, gets the credit for "smelling" out the animal!) #31-Trail-also outside-you pick your own scenery & setting for the judging. #32-working cow pony-w/cattle, please bring your own-also possibly judged outside. #33-Eng. Breed's WP-for SB, TWH, & other breeds not usually shown in WP. NOT in reference to arab or morgan, as they're shown in open WP all the time. This class is designed to give your other breeds a chance to show WP! #38-Novelty class; anything goes, for any class I've missed-judged alot on imagination, too, for what things new & exciting you can think up!

\*\*#11 & 12 will be combined if there aren't enuf entries-so bring your Walkers!

#36 & 37 are open to horses shown either WP or EP or even bareback; decide on only one for each horse, please. No switching tack in the middle of the class!

**AWARDS:** Commercial flats, 1st-5th each class, placings to 10th, 2 HM's added if entries exceed 40 horses. Comm. flat or small rosette to Judge's Choices, and comm. rosettes to champs & Reserves.

**JUDGING:** Each judge will have a clipboard & columns for points. All classes judged on this pt. system except for the fox hunt. Races are determined by using cards; there are several alternatives to other race details that'll be worked out when everyone gets here.

**CLASS SPONSERS:** Due to the high cost of the awards & low comm. entry fee, I'm offering classes open for you to sponsor; another words, you pay for the cost of the 5 ribbons in that class, and in return, you get a full page of free ad space in the HSR. The cost of 5 ribbons is approx. 8¢ (Unless Stineman goes up again.) and you'd be paying 40¢. If this idea works, fine, if not, that's OK too! It just occurred to me that that's what they do in real horse shows! Even if you're not coming, you may still sponsor a class or classes. Please send in your 'sponsors' as soon as possible, telling which class(es) you want, giving 2nd choice in case the class is already taken. OK?

\*\*If this date does not suit anyone, let me know-if too many people can't come, the show will be postponed. Among those who want to come are Cheryl Williams, Karen Heinitz, Margie Lancaster (El Dorado, Ks.) Judi Davison, (Topeka Ks.) & Mlie Jeffries (Raleigh, NC!!)-there are more who'd like to come, but aren't sure yet. I hope many more of you can come now that the date is set!! Bring your sleeping bags!!! If anyone would like to come early, or stay after the show to help us build the fences & barn, you're very welcome!! Turn the page & read more about it in my "Notes..."

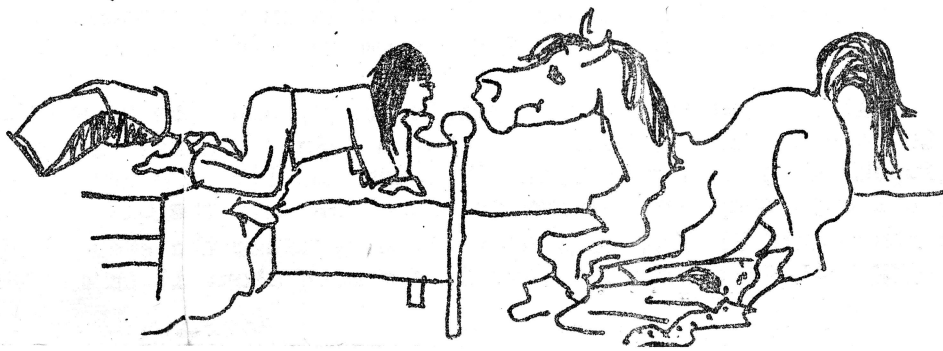
I could use a couple more cover models....

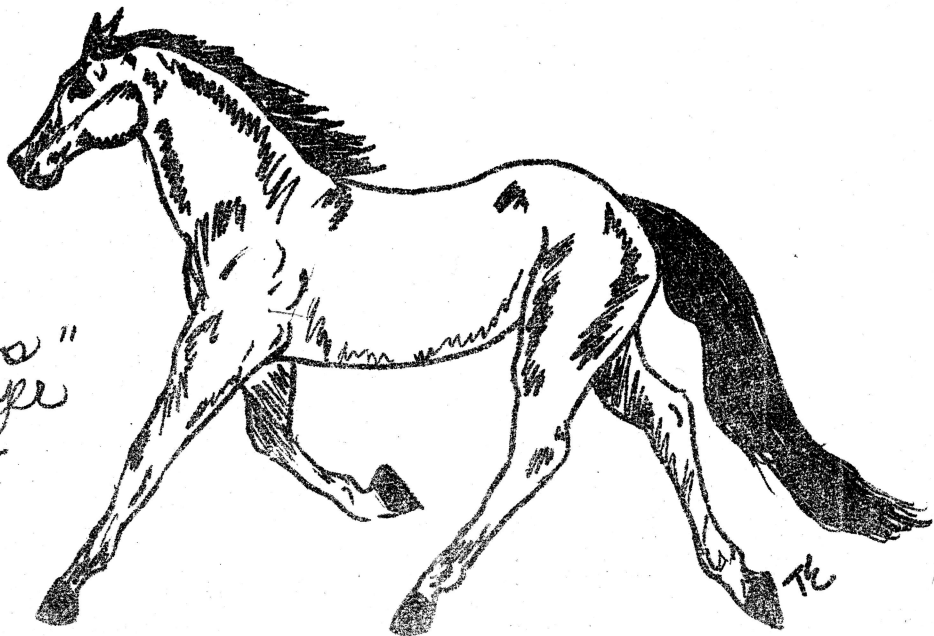
