20 words or less - 5¢

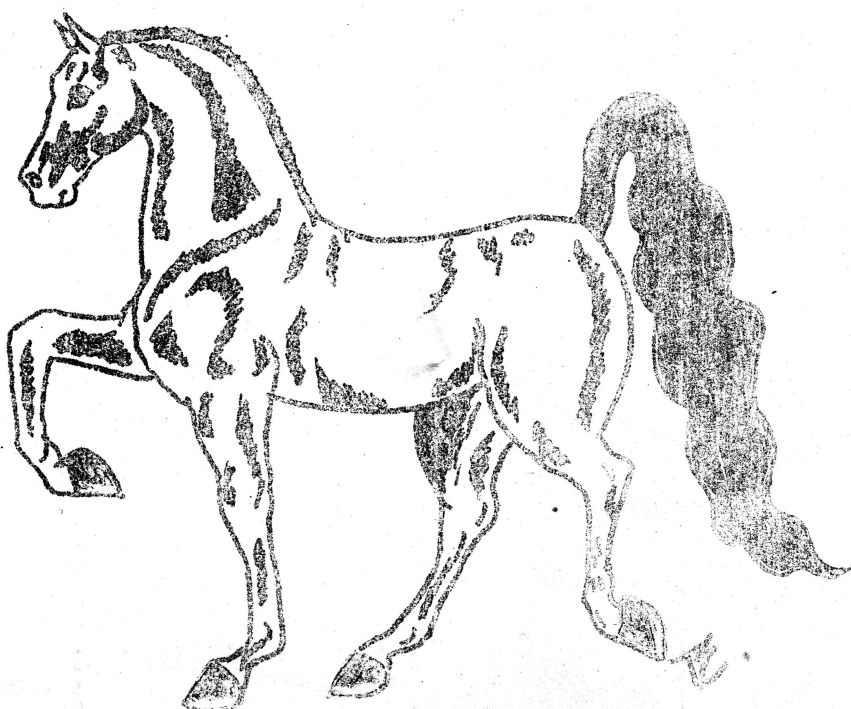
The HSR is printed monthly. All items for each issue are due on the 25th of each month. For
