

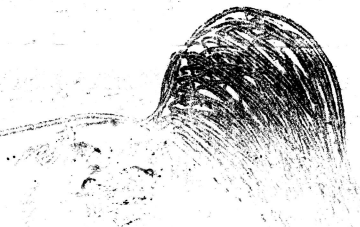

"We've just recently purchased a large addition to our TB string. We have acquired the stallion BOLD SENTINEL and 3 mares. Sentinel is the Brey. SM "Citation" in a gorgeous shade of bay. His sire is the famous BOLD RULER, a great stud. Since we have had him, Sentinel has sired 3: TECHKOVANY PRIDE (an app colt,) ADAM & HILDEGARDE (twin TB foals). The appy colt is old enough to start competition, and he should do very well. W/his bloodlines, he should develop into a tremendous running horse. (Bold Ruler was also the grandsire of such greats as Honest Pleasure and Bold Forbes!!) The TB colts are too young to start showing yet. Their dam is SHASLA DAISY, one of our new mares. She's the chestnut SM. The other 2 newcomers are SHASTA'S SMOKEY (a black mare) & SHASTA'S CALUMET (bay.) We're also looking for a TB stallion w/good conformation (similar to that of the Brey. "Citation" but preferably larger,) to carry the name SHASTA CHARGER. The real Shasta is a magnificent black TB stud o/b our neighbor's stables. Falls across these gallent steeds.

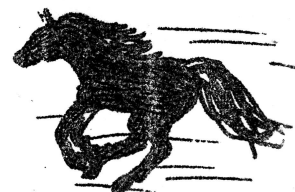

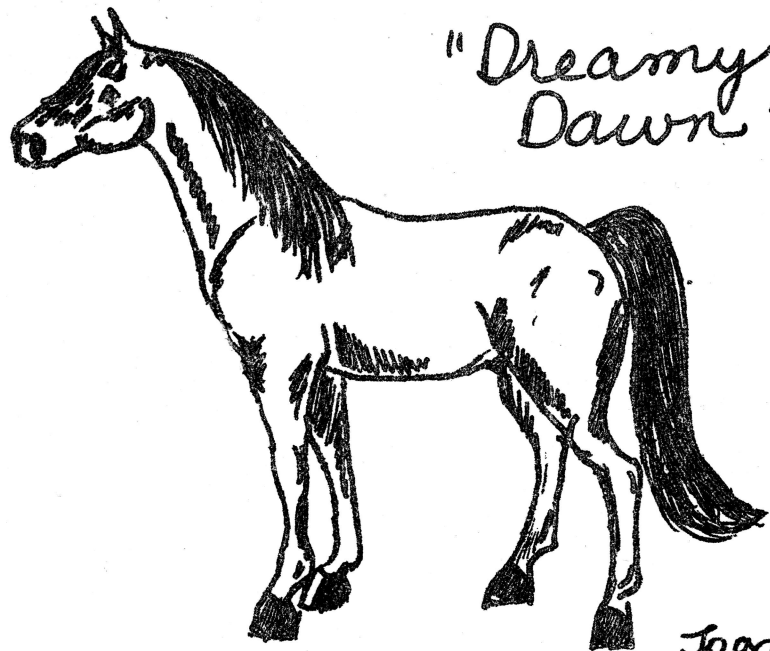
