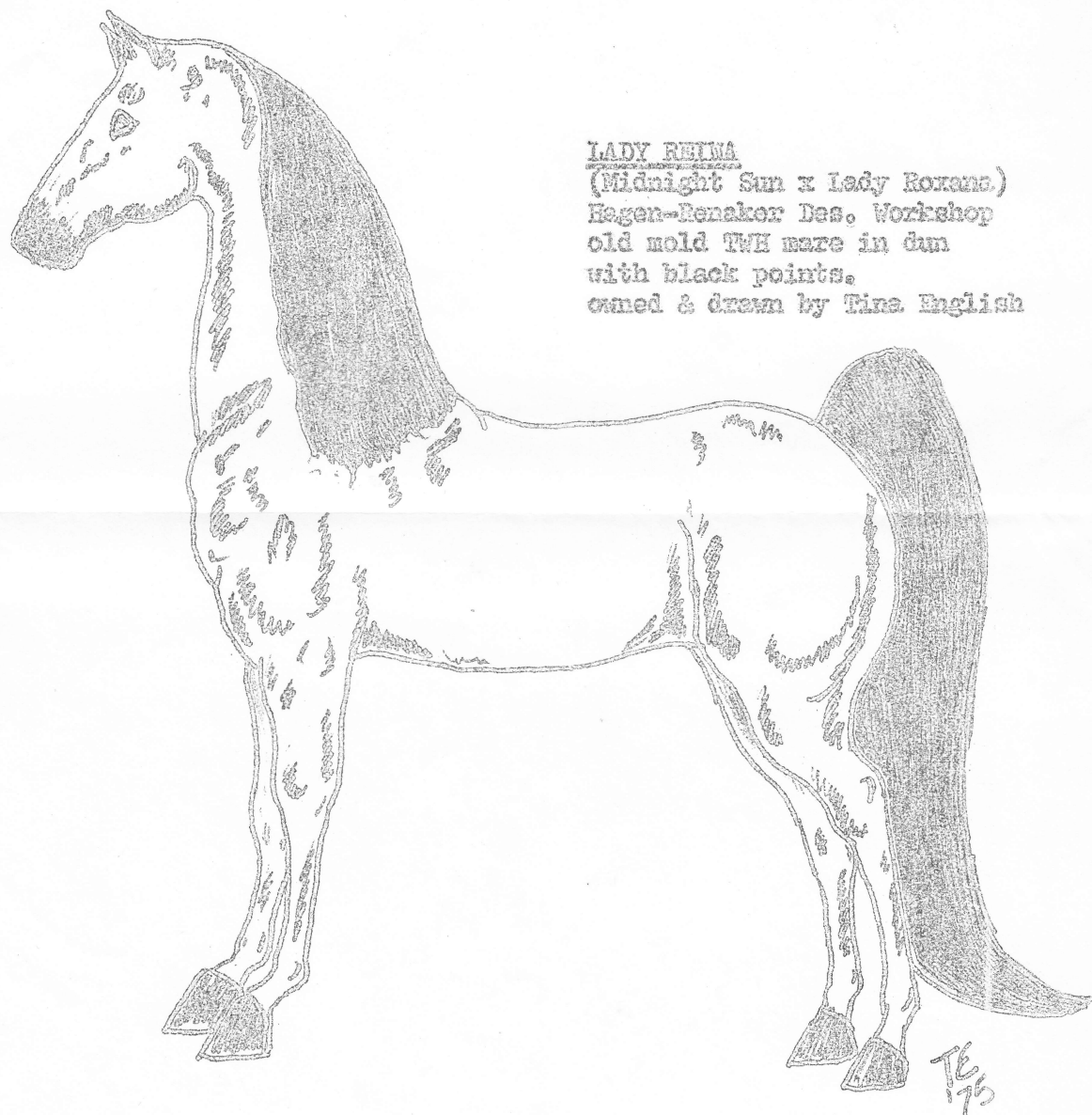

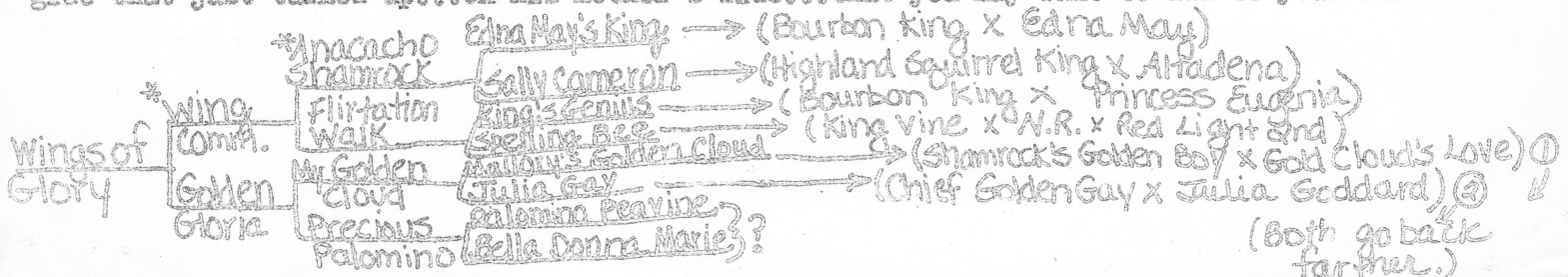
See how many famous horses (& a famous jockey, + the words "Famous Horses") you can find in this puzzle!

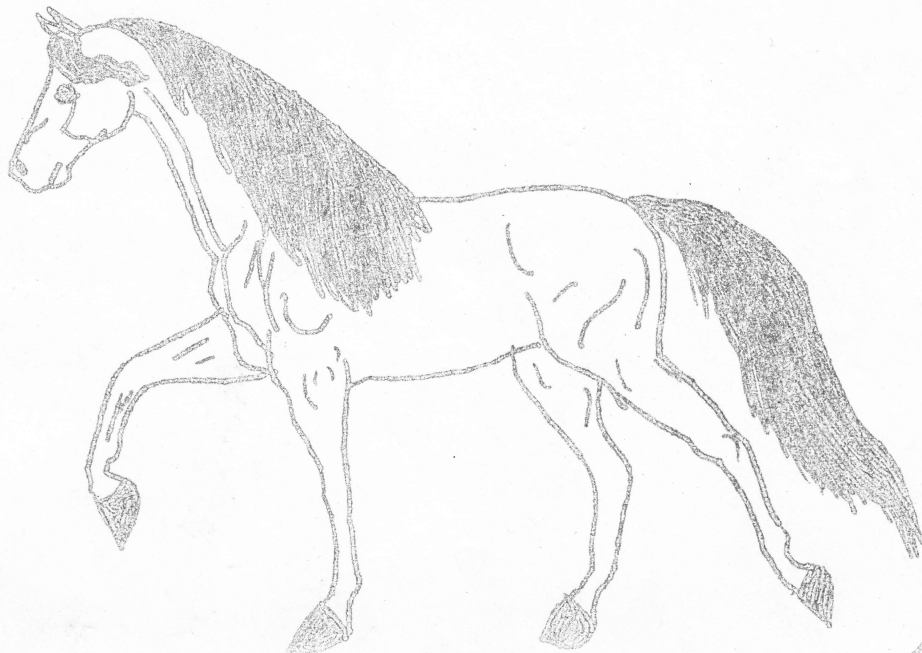
