



This time really delights me as we have a treasure of antique Drafters from Lynn Erny. You all know how much I adore these heavyweight beauties! I'm dying to hear about them, Lynn. Take it away: "CLALLAM & CLE ELUM are twin dap. grey Shire mares, made of plaster & age of both is unknown except that these plaster molds are no longer being made. Their original colors were a dingy shade of dk. ivory on one & a dismal bayish color, w/very grimy white stockings & blaze on the other. They came originally out of the same mold, but when I bought them, one was gotten for 35¢ (the bay) & the other (cream) was \$2! They now have proudly joined my small but fine quality Drafter models band. Since I bought them, they have gained names, ages & parents. MacDuff (blk. Shire stal.), also of plaster but 13" to the ears, is their sire & a dap. grey Shire mare called Duchess is their dam. (I hope to own Duchess someday..She's Breyer's grey Shire.) Both models have been registered in the No. ~~447188~~ West Model Draft Horse Registry. CLALLAM has a star & snip while Sle ELUM has a star, connected strip & snip. That's the only way I can tell them apart. Their tails are tied like Breyer's Belgian stallion, while their manes are long & loose except for an Aberdeen roll down the crest of their necks. This is now blue & white as is the tail cord. Their ages are now recorded as 5 years..."

I thoroughly enjoyed hearing about your beauties, Lynn. They must be out of this world! If you ever sell them, let me know. Would love to see photos of them...Until next time, all write in! Bye!

Sorry I skipped a few months--went on vacation to Canada & neglected to send in the copy. A lot of you have been asking how to put a real hair mane/tail on a model, & since I haven't done too much of this work myself, I can't promise directions will be too accurate. There may be an easier way, but the following procedure has proven very successful on my models. The material I use is acrylic fur that can be bought in most of your larger hobby shops. It comes on a knitted backing & is normally used to make fur flower arrangements. You'll also need some tacky white glue, not Elmer's (Ed. Have used it with success.) or some types of plastic cement (won't stick hair down), so get something good. For a mane, take the fur & cut out a piece in the shape you want the mane to be. Don't cut the fur off the backing tho. Then glue this mane piece over the plastic mane on your model & arrange the lay of the hair w/hair spray (mane spray?). You can also make forelocks curl backward by glueing it down to the horse's face in the pattern you want it to lay in. For a tail, first cut off the original plastic one. Then cut a strip of hair from 2-3" wide & as long as you wish the tail to be. Roll the hair into a long tube shape & stitch it closed leaving one end open so that it resembles an elongated bag. Now take the open end & glue it down to the horse's hip over the hole where its orig. tail came off. Make sure your stitching is turned towards the legs of the horse so that it won't show. Then arrange the hair the way you want it to lay & spray it w/hair spray. Work slowly & carefully.



If you wish to leave the orig. tail on your model, you can apply the hair right over the tail by cutting the hair right in 1/2-1" strips & glueing it directly around the tail in rings starting at the bottom of the tail. See A. Let that ring dry & then apply another higher up to cover more of the tail. Continue until you have the entire tail covered.

Both ways become less complicated after they've been practiced awhile. If anyone has a different/better method of applying hair to a model, please write to me! One last answer: SASE is the term applied by a shower to a self-addressed stamped envelope, & TB is short for Thoroughbred. Keep the questions coming in! Bye...



del should be wrapped carefully so as not to break it in shipment. Wrap

To the great MHSJ folks, A HUGE THANKYOU! Over ~~\$1150~~\$150 of the \$250 was raised by you! The folks of Louisville, & the many Arab Fair visitors heard the story over & over of your great hearts. Hopefully next issue of MHSJ will have the promised photo page (Linda's overworked so if my ad doesn't get in, it'll be there soon!) but for now, a brief rundown. We left several hours late the 8th of May (usual procedure for me). 6 hours later LOUISVILLE! We immediately set about decorating the stalls, and 12 hours later we finished, showered, & were ready for the first day. But when the doors opened and the thousands of people poured in, I nearly ran the other way! Twenty-four hours without sleep and THIS! All day they came, viewing 89 of the nation's finest Arabian stallions in what was to be the most elaborate setting any Arab ever dreamed of! 




