A lot of you have been asking how to put a real hair mane/tail on a model, & since I haven't done too much of this work myself, I can't promise directions will be too accurate. There may be an easier way, but the following procedure has proven very successful on my moclosed leaving one dels. The material I use ks acrylic fur that can be end open bought in most of your larger hobby shops. It comes on a knitted backing & is normally used to make fur flower arrangements. You'll also need some glue open tacky white glue, not Emer's (Ed. Have used it with end to horse, success.) or some types of plastic cement (won't stick hair down), so get something good. For a mane, take toward legs the fur & cut out a piece in the shape you want the mane to be. Don't cut the fur off the backing tho. Then glue this mane piece over the plastic mane on your model & arrange the lay of the hair w/hair spray (mane spray?). You can also make foreleocks curl backwork upward by glueing it down to the horse's face in the pattern you want it to lay in. For a tail, first cut off the original plastic one. Then cut a strip of hair from 2-3" wide & as long as you wish the tail to be. Roll the hair into a long tube shape & stitch it closed leaving one end open so that it resembles an elongated bag. Now take the open end & glue it down to the horse's hip over the holle where its orig. tail came off. Make sure your stitching is turned towards the legs of the horse so that it won't show. Then arrange the hair the way you want it to lay & spray it w/hair spray. Work slowly & carefully. If you wish to leave the orig. tail on your model, you can apply the hair right over the tail by cutting the hair right in 2-1" strips & glueing it directly around the tail in rings starting at the bottom of the tail. See A. Let that ring dry & then apply another higher up to cover more of the tail. Continue until you have the entire tail covered. Both ways become less complicated after the pive been practiced awhile. If anyone has a different/better method of applying hair to a model, please write to me... hand, let me clear up a few here. And away we go...

"I don't think it's fair you pay postage & insurance & the person doesn't insure it when sending it!..Also, do NOT mail horses (ceramic/glass) in a SHOE BOX! They get crushed! Whenever mailing such, pack it well in two boxes or wrap it with bubble paper or newspaper. Also wrap the model's kegs, head/tail, please! If wrapped in thin paper, use many layers! Doesn't it make you mad when this happens? esp. to beloved H-R's?.." DS (Ed.A model should be wrapped carefully so as not to break it in shipment. Wrap the limbs, tail, head, etc. gently with cotton cloth or quilting. Use a lot! Better to pay postage than lose the model. Next place the "mummy" in a strong cardboard box. Place this one inside of, another lined with either excelsior, crushed newspaper or shredded paper. Seal tight & pray...

"Shows' fees & ribbons! The former are always going up while the quality of the latter going down! When I pay \$1 to enter a show, I usually also pay 80¢41 on postage. Plus \$50¢ & over fee (though I hardly ever enter those), then when I come home with scraps of paper for 1st, 2nd, 3rd, etc. just with such written crudely on them...grr. In my shows I manage to make GOOD ribbons up to 6th with a 25¢ fee. Also a 50¢ fee w/ribbons homemade to 3rd & only 20 classes is stupid..." Name Withheld...

"Why aren't there more performance classes? Not pleasure called 'Perf.' but true perf. classes, where a good horse can show his/her talents. Like cutting; roping, stock dry work (no livestock), or work with livestock, jumping, dressage, or what have you. Also WHY in ALL trail classes must the horse go over the same old thin logs? There are lots of others, haven' you ever seen a live show that had a trail class & saw amailbox (easy to make), tires (to be potholes—off toys), water, livestock, hillslopes(believe it or not many horses cannot go down or up hills safely), trees, poles, jumps, backing though an "L", stand hobbled, or even groundtied! The obstacles are often left up to the imagination. Also, if split reins are not used, hobbles are to be carried... "CM"

Comment on names: "Most live animal registries have a limit on the number of letters in the name, counting punctuations but not spaces: 18, 21, 25 (the limit). I think we should do the same. 
