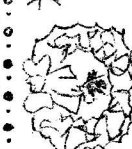

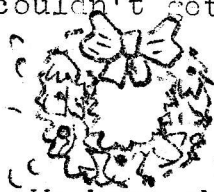

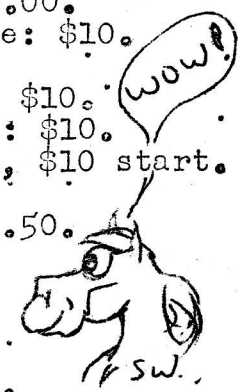

Register as many horses/foals/ponies as you have. Send info to registrar Linda Cannarsa at 34 Renwick Ave., Huntington, N.Y. 11743. Once regis. you enter regular shows at a lower fee, 40¢ mem- bers, 50¢ non-members. Regular BVHC shows are held every 5 weeks. A reg. horse collects points when he enters a BVHC show. Point scale: Grand Ch.=15, Res.Gr.=14, Div.Ch.=12, Res.=10, 1st=8, 2nd=7, 3rd=6, 4th=5, 5th-10th=1. Collect points for yr. end awards high point. High Pt. Horse Owner, Stal., Mare, Geld. & Foal are awarded beautiful prizes at year's end. Also when 1 horse receives a certain amount of points he gets a prize. HORSE: Honorable Mention 100 pts., Register of Merit (ROM) 500 pts., Halter ROM 200 pts., Perf. ROM 300, Supreme Champion 1000. FOAL: Honorable Mention 50 pts., ROM 250 pts., Supreme Champion 500. From time to time the BVHC holds raffles, auctions, special shows, etc. We hold GRAND NATIONALS annually where members receive double pts. w/comm. ribbons. LITTLE KNOWN BREEDS: Bette Brown, see Stallion Road Stables ad!

Are KNABSTRUPS knocking you cuckoo? Since we have talked about the Colorado Rangers & you know about the Appaloosa, what is more logical than to talk about a breed which is their cousin? If you watched the European circuses on tv, you may have seen spotted horses you thought were Apps. If they were lightweight animals, probably they were Knabstrups or "Tiger Horses" (Noriker or Pinzgauer) if heavier. For some reason spotted horses in Europe are called "Tigers" while we usually associate stripes w/tigers & leopards with spots. As the App & Rangerbred came so did the orig. horse left in Denmark by a Spanish soldier. They sport the same coloration as the App but have a fuller m/t. (The App only seems to sport a sparse tail which was due to selective breeding.) The breed dates back to the Napolianic Wars when a spotted mare was left behind & used to pull a butcher's cart until discovered by a Major Lunn, who owned the Knabstrup Estates. So came the name of the breed. The mare was a chest. w/blanket & wh. mane/tail. "Flaebheppen" was bred to a Palo. stal. whose ancestors were from the Royal Frederiksborg Stud, and in 1813 a colt was born. He must have been something to see, because he combined the color of sire/dam with a metallic hue. Named "Flaebhingsten", he became the Foundation sire of the breed. Denmark loves this breed & has more than one society for him as well as several studs....Added note: Cynthia Welch let me know the Colo. Ranger Horse Assoc. lives! And the breed is gaining in popularity. Spotted horses forever!

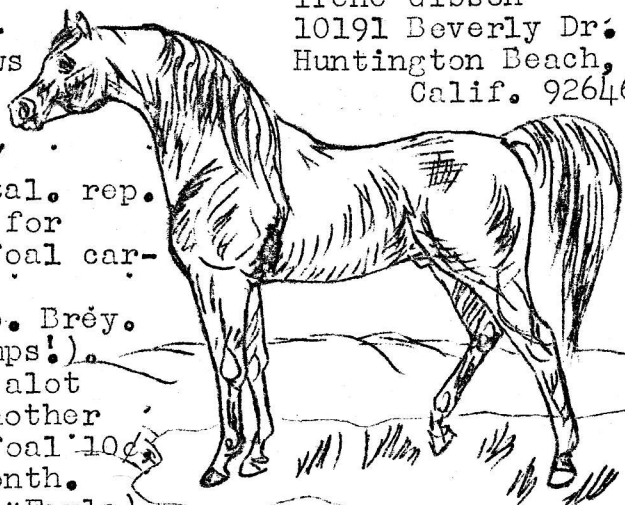

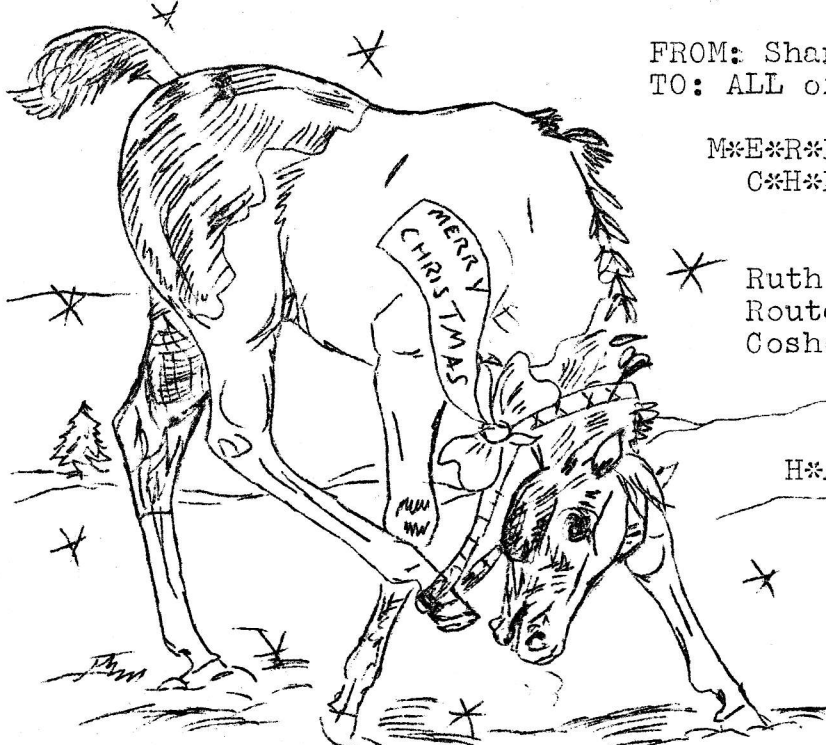

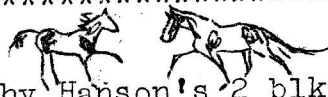
HOW DO YOU FLOCK A MODEL? I've never flocked one but I've done a couple of squirrel models. Your hobby shop carries a fuzzy material called (what else?) "Flock" & it comes in several colors. Also try to obtain a can of spray glue. If you can't find this then you can take Elmer's or any other type of white glue & thin it w/water to a consistency where it will brush on in a very thin layer. Next fashion a squeeze bottle for the flocking. This can be made from a soft plastic medicine bottle w/ a small hole cut in the lid. The hole should be just big enough that when squeezed the flocking sifts through in a fine spray of fur. Fill it with your flock & then prepare your model. If the model is to have any white markings (such as star or stocking) cut some masking tape in their exact shape & stick it on the model where the markings will be. Do the base body color first. Spray or brush the glue onto your model in a small area at a time & then fluff the flocking onto the model. If some areas come out bumpy you can smooth them down before the glue dries with a piece of wax paper. When done w/the body color, let your model dry for awhile & then remove the masking tape & do your markings in white the same way. Keep the body color covered so no glue will adhere to the flocking. For mixed colors on horses you can blend colors in a shoe box before putting them into the squeeze bottle. A reddish brown & white for strawberry roans, grey & white for greys, etc. Have fun experimenting! I don't know of any company selling flocked models except Steha (or Lteha) & Diercks and Algyre; The West German Co. (Steha) horses are usually 5" on up, made of heavy plastic & flocked. Their address is not know and I don't believe they put out a catalog for collectors. Bye for '74!

Hello! Again this time we feature Edith Powell's findings, and so away we go into mixing enamels. If you use dk. grey (aircraft grey) & light gr. (camouflage gr.) you can get all shades of grey for dapples, roans, etc. Use dk. earth (brown) and add other colors for various bays. If you need a dk. olive green, mix choco. brown & yellow! The color wood tan is a good buckskin color, so if you use your imagination, you can come up w/all sorts of good ones. In acrylics, yellow ocre & burnt sienna mixed make great chestnut shades. Burnt sienna is also tops for red roans. So happy mixing!...Here's another top hint from Linda Stange who says if you take those containers tomatoes & strawberries come in, they make handy corner feeders in your model barns. You also can make water buckets out of mouthwash bottle caps! The larger ones are a good size for Breyers! And if you have something plain around the house, paint something horsey on it, like an old glass jar, using paint by numbers sets. It works she says!...A hint here from an old shower (yeh, me). When the weather gets VERY cold, those who have H-R's can tell you the weather CAN break them. If it gets too cold, be careful, because they do tend to turn brittle. As for B eyers, keep them away from extreme heat or you may melt them. Bye!

THE TACK CORNER



This month we have another interesting article from Beth Peart of Canada. One of her many horse-oriented hobbies is specialty tack making. She just finished creating a British trooping set, like the horses wear in the Queen's birthday parade, w/genuine purple leather sad, blanket embroidered in gold & red.

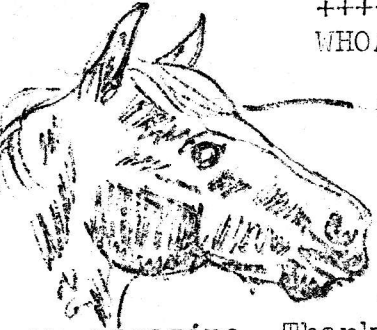
The bridle is a complicated unit with pom-poms in gold crisscrossing chain, gilt-gold double bit, gold curb chain & buckles. The saddle is all leather w/gilt stirrups, breastplate & chainwork w/heart-shaped brass on the front. Completing the set, the horse wears a bearskin in front of the saddle & a rope tie. Whow, that's a lot of work!! According to Beth the key to successful tack-making is proper equipment & patience. The best leather she says is 2-2½ ounce carving weight but scraps from a shoe factory also work. Sturdy thread, leather cement, glove leather, thin rawhide, hooks & eyes, wood splints & wire should fill out the workbox. Work slowly when making anything, and the carving leather can be cut, tooled, & worked into different shapes. Diagram your task & use pix to get an inkling of authenticity. Upon returning home, my Dr. really threw affit & as I'd picked up a rather nasty cold, he said it bordered on pneumonia & he hospitalized me. He'd also discovered a breast tumor so during my long stay, I also had surgery for this. It was NOT cancerous. (With all the recent publicity on breast cancer, don't think it can only happen to someone else. And don't think you're too young. Any suspicious lump should be reported to your doctor immediately!) I'm writing this on my 2nd day home from the hospital so you can see the lack of time I've had. It will be another 3-4 months before I can ride again (the horses should be glad!) & I'll be using crutches for some time. But I'm out of bed several hours a day & should be on the stack of mail that's piled up. We had a wonderful summer of live horshowing, going somewhere nearly every weekend, w/INCA bringing home many more blues. Showing w/him this year: INCA'S FANCI JEWEL, (his '74 daughter!), OKLAHOMA SNOSTORM, A-M WIND WITCH, IBN GWALIOR. All terrific Arabians! I'm proudest of Inca's win in the Trail Class in S. C. & possession of the "Mr. Sol--Jeff Spivy Transcontinental Trail Ride" Trophy. A fabulous trophy dedicated to a great event. Next year we hope for a larger van (which I'll learn not to hang onto the sides of when it's moving) & shows from Va. to Texas. I haven't forgotten my promise to show some photos of the Arabian Horse Fair to you great MHSJ readers! Look for it in early Spring! It was a fabulous Fair! I lack a few photos yet to several contributors I meant to write personal letters to & set aside your letters for this purpose. I haven't lost them & you'll very shortly have them. To you Auction buyers of my models, a big THANKS & most of you should have your models by now. Much success showing these babies! I wish each & every one of you many Championships in shows to come! Just because I haven't entered model shows lately, don't think I'm out of business. Just TIME! But that should change this winter so expect the great multi-Champions Countess Dorsaz, The Witchdoctor, Fantazia, *Robot, Reuben, & all the rest back soon. '74 was a great model year for us & a big thanks to the showers who bought from us & judges who liked us. We bought quite a few models, Beswicks all over the place! Found some old H-R's too.
