Continuing with racing breeds of other nations, we find the EAST BULGARIAN, which was bred thru selective choices by using Anglo-Arab & Eng. TB's or cross-bred Eng. mares. They are well-developed, compact & graceful horses. The GERMAN HANO-VERIAN was at 1 time a great warhorse, but in the recent century the same bloodlines which are the foundations of the Ebg. & Amer. TB's were used. The result was a good-looking, popular & well-known horse much in demand these days ... The well-known HOLSTEIN was developed from Andalusian stock & they excell in steeplechasing & jumping. They are tall horses but graceful and courageous...The last TB type is the German TRAKEHNER, Using Arab & Eng. TB blood a local breed was built up & the result is a beautifully proportioned animal. W.W.II nearly wiped them out but now the Trakehnen Stud is supported by Poland and a branch herd is in W. Germany known by an older name, East Prussian. All the breeds are so similar to the horse we call 'Thoroughbred', & so many have had TB blood infused into them, that only their native names differentiates them it seems. Bye for this session!





Hi! We have a couple of tip top hints this time: When painting pasterns on the back side, you can roll your brush if hat's what you're using around in a motion like the picture. That way you avoid getting paint on the hooves! Great tip!...Now, to make gorgeous barrel racing barrels, just take an empty cleaned out coke can & paint it! It's really cheap & works wonders w/Breyer-sized horses. To make poles for that event, take spools & stick a dowel rod in it, paint & set it up. It looks super! Thanks for all the tips, people!

I've known some mares to have as many as 3 foals per year (gestation period is 11 months, hai), & while busy w/all these foals she's being shown! Does this ever happen in real breeding/showing operations? I've made it a rule none of my mares are open except to friends & she is used for breeding only! Even then they are restricted to 1 foal per yr. It's nice to share your mare w/outside horses but there's such a thing as ôverdoing it. What are fillies going to end up like if they have foals when they're only year-lings themselves?" AP (Ed.Swaybacked, that's what! Or poorly developed..)


"About all the gripes on 35mm pix doing better than instam. pix...I recently held a show & had lots of varied entrants w/all types of pix.....

Most of the imsta. pix entered were rotten. Sure an instam. won't take a close-up shot but that doesn't mean you can't get a good pic of the horse if you hold that camera steady or rest it on something. The majority of the pix I saw were blurred from jiggling the camera. I don't think people are prejudiced against instam. shots, it's just a lot of you instam. photographers don't take the careful steps to get good pix the 35mm people do. Don't try to get too close either, that'll blur the pic. The few who do take care when using their instam. will get good pix & win ribbons w/them. I saw several, & they won ribbons at my show." Name Withheld

"I always add 2-3 extra stamps in my envelope when sent to a show to cover the expense back, but most always they are not used. The showholder keeps them (maybe unintentionally) but losing 20-30¢ per show is hard to take especially when I get stamps every 3 weeks & often run out because of that..." Anonymous...Ed.Be careful, folks. Return everything you do not need and be sure those extra stamps go back. Have lost a few myself because the showholder did not take time to check everything. Okay?

"In the Oct. issue you had a Gripe from a person whose horses were not placing 'cause instam, pix aren't as good as the 35mm, for getting close ups. She also said she didn't have the money to buy an expensive camera. All I can say is 'Pshawi' You don't need anything other than a cheap lens, Tiffew Close-Up +1 for instam.--100/150-4 (about \$3). Enclosed is a pic w/real background w/a Zara H-R Arab mare, 6" in it. It is clear, placed 7th in a large class (70)..." Ed.She showed me the pic & it's a beauty! In fact it was better than some 35mm shots I've seen of the same mold! The setting enhanced the model & brought out her beauty, and you had it close up enough to see details beautifully and clearly. It was not blurred and was taken down on the same level as she. That's another tip, take pix level with the model in order to avoid foreshortening the legs. There's nothing funnier to judge than a 1" legged high model that really stands 10" tall! Watch your angles & watch that blurring. And you will do far better. Thanks for listening! Bye...More next issue.
