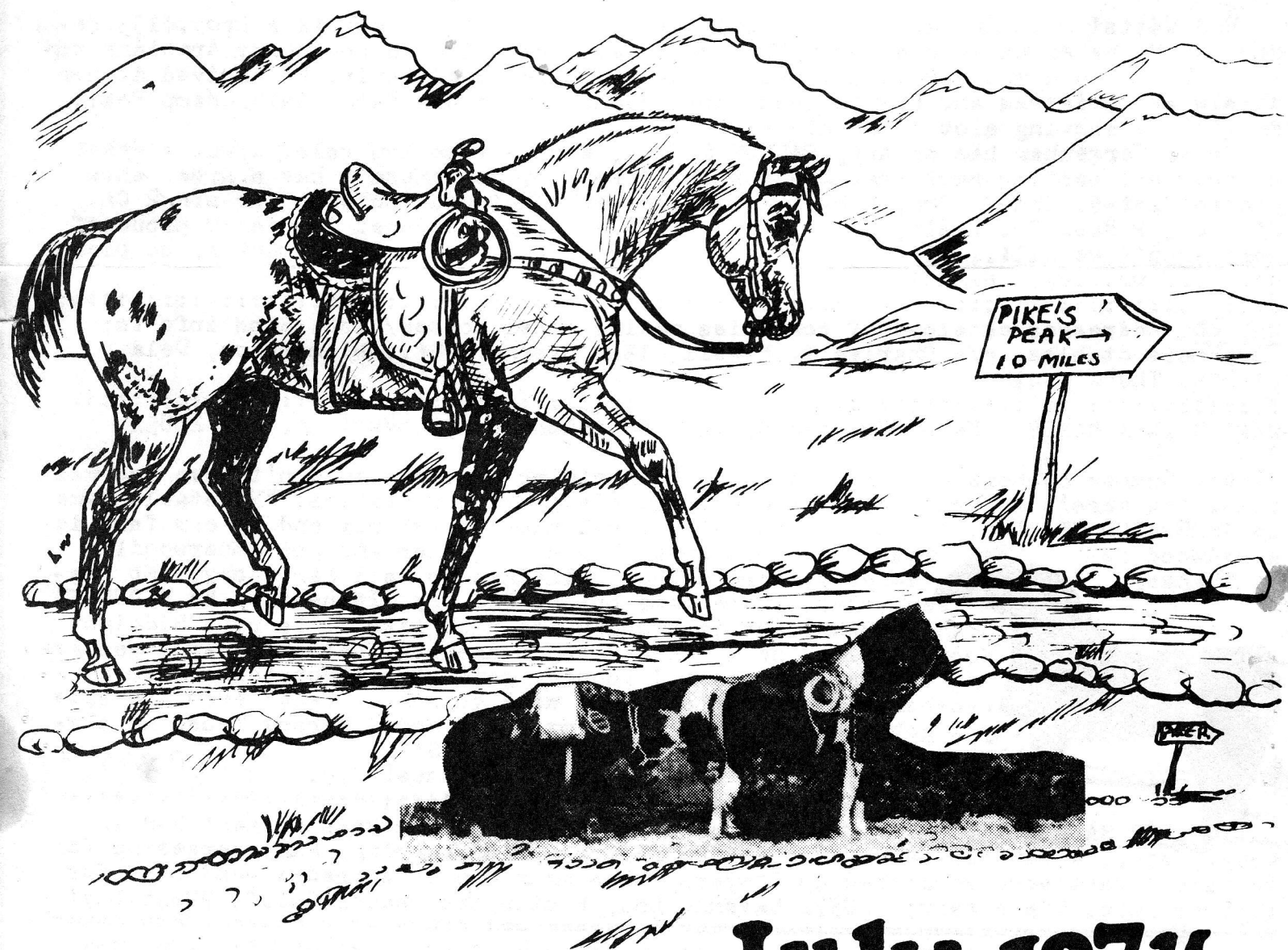

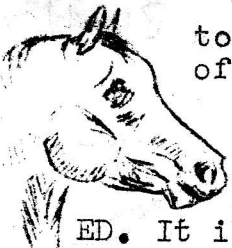
AD RATES: \$1.50 per ad, whether full or only partial page. This rate applies to 1 stable ad (stal. at stud or mare for hire, lists of them, etc.), 1 class list, 1 long list of models/tack for sale (as long as it fills 1 page, if it goes over, then an additional \$15.00 must be paid), or 1 ad "thank you", etc. NOT all you can cram onto 1 sheet of paper. If you combine a class list & a stable/registry ad, that constitutes TWO ads, NOT 1. So please watch it, folks, and if the ad is underpaid for, it WILL NOT BE RUN. Some of you continue to pay the ancient rate, and that MUST STOP. So no payment, no ad run. Thanky! Sorry to be grouchy, but it gets pretty expensive notifying the same people time & again of their error.

Someone asked me recently HOW MUCH does it cost to produce 1 month's worth of copies, mail them, etc. Okay, since I've not bothered y'all before with financial reports, will do so here. Paper=\$70 (all prices approx.), prof. pages=\$30., postage=\$65, ink=\$20, tape/staples=\$1.50, ~~stencils~~ stencils=\$14. for a total of about \$200.50 PER ISSUE (475 copies) PER MONTH. Break that down, and you can see how little your ads cost you. Okay? So no more gripes on the ad costs, please...This issue: It is sold to roughly 470 people as I type this. MHSJ AUCTION: Howdy--as you can see in the last pages of the MHSJ, we have

TON of great models offered for sale! Hope you will find something to buy. Here are the basic rules/guidelines for the auction, hope they make sense!
#1. Please send all bids to Miss Kay McCue, 1105 Catalpa Dr., Middletown, Ohio 45042. (I'm forwarding all the SASE's from the horses-submitted part to her.) Send NO bids to me.

#2. Bids are DUE in by AUGUST 30th at the latest. Get them in early!

#3. Send NO money to Kay, ONLY your bid(s). You may send in two bids on the same model, 1 bid and another slightly higher if you like; so that if your 1st bid is outbid, you will have another in on the horse. Tell Kay the model's name, the division it comes under (such as Lefton, H-R, etc.) & the model's number, plus send in how much you bid on it. Send NO money, remember. Highest bid gets the model.

#4. Bids may be the same as the set price (minimum asked, printed beside the model's description), or they may be over the set price at any amount you wish. Bids may NOT be under the set price. If they are, they will be disqualified. Please be sure to include your name/address with the bid & also a SASE (if you sent in one when you submitted models to the auction, you need not send in another with bids.)

#5. After the bidding is finished, Kay will notify you of your purchases, in your SASE if sent. She will state your bid (highest) & tell you what horse(s) you purchased. Included will be the name/address of the model's owner. You will then send to them the amount of money bid LESS the 10% to go to the MHSJ. (Example: If your bid was \$20.00, then 10% of that is \$2, which you send to L. Walter at the MHSJ Address. The remaining \$18.00 you will send to the model's owner, plus postage!) Remember to send sufficient postage for the model(s) you buy, and if you buy from more than one person, please be sure to keep your records straight. (You may send one lump sum of the 10% owed the MHSJ rather than sending several checks or money orders for separate models bought.) Please be prompt in sending the 10% as well as the remaining 90% to the model's owner. We are counting on all of you to be honest in your dealings with the MHSJ & with the buyers/sellers.

#6. When the model's owner receives your fee, she will send the model to you. She will have been notified by Kay of the models selling and to whom. If you prefer to work out terms with the buyer/seller, then do so, but the 10% of the selling price MUST be sent posthaste. Model owners, please send models out promptly upon receiving the payment. Thanky!

Well, I reckon that is it, as the saying goes. If anything crops up unexpectedly, such as unforeseen problems, they will be aired in the Aug. MHSJ. Thanks very much to everyone who sent in models for the auction. I hope to place a few bids myself! Yummy! Get to reading, and happy buying!

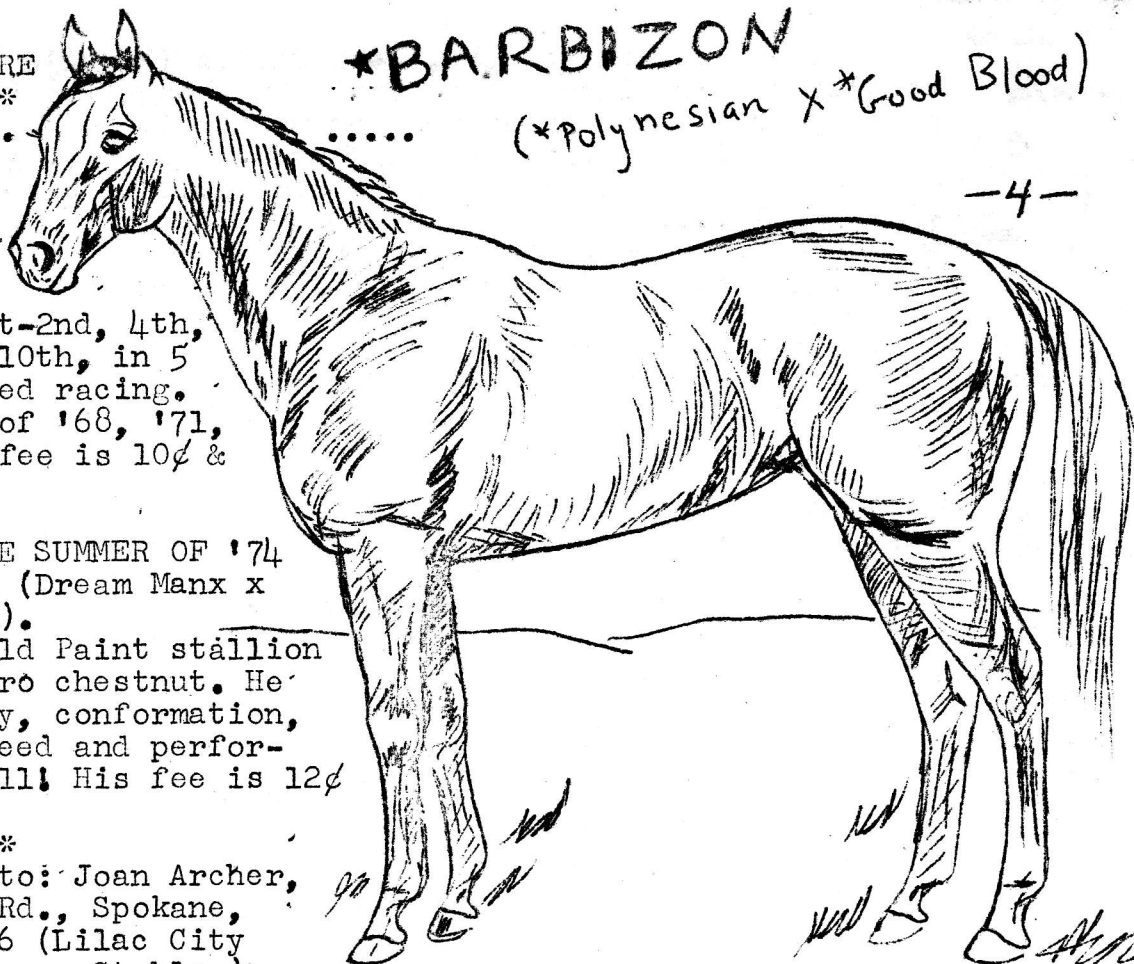

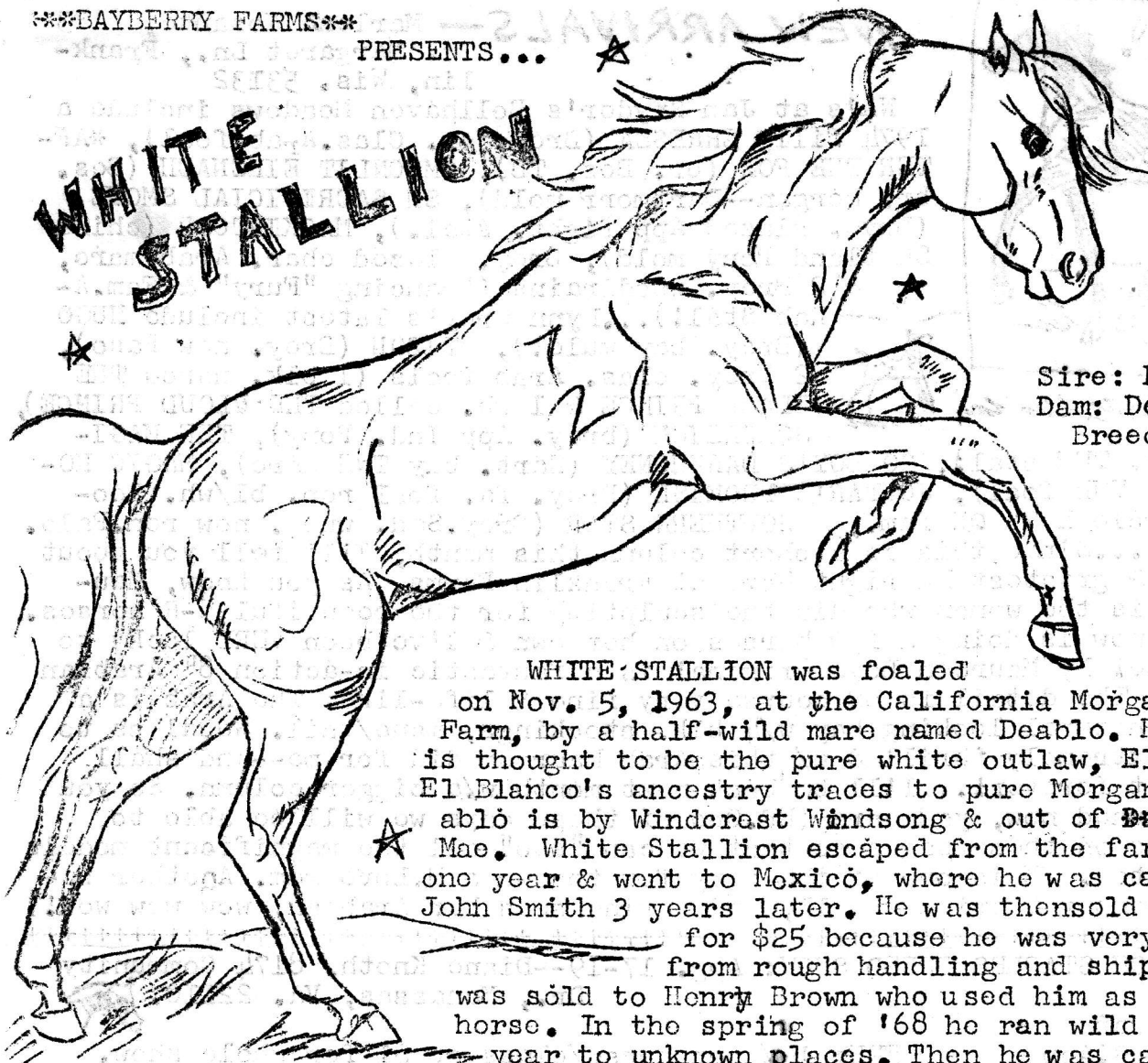

WHITE STALLION was foaled on Nov. 5, 1963, at the California Morgan Horse Farm, by a half-wild mare named Deablo. His sire is thought to be the pure white outlaw, El Blanco. El Blanco's ancestry traces to pure Morgans, & Deablo is by Windcrest Windsong & out of ~~Dea~~ Lazy Mae. White Stallion escaped from the farm at age one year & went to Mexico, where he was captured by John Smith 3 years later. He was then sold at auction for \$25 because he was very thin from rough handling and shipping. He was sold to Henry Brown who used him as a ranch horse. In the spring of '68 he ran wild for a year to unknown places. Then he was caught by me. I show him under halter, EP, WP, Trail and harness & he's got Top Ten HVMHC. He has raced well also and is a full-blooded Champ Stallion. He is a stud and some of his get are Nightingale & Flicka. They are very good show horses.

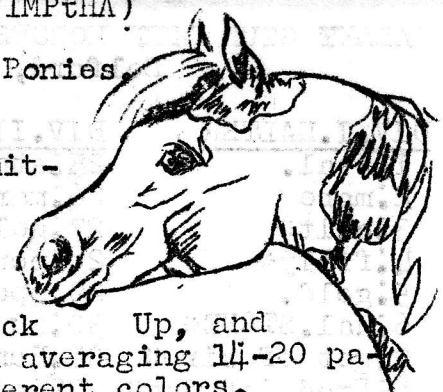

of Arabians, Morgans, Plantation horses, Saddlers, Walkers & Quarter Hor-
ses. This was one and a half Centuries ago! With the addition of Standard
bred blood to give pleasing appearance & disposition, the early breeders
of Missouri finally developed & evolved & standardized the Fox-Trotters.
A stud book for the breed was incorporated in 1948 & the registry is still
open for horses which can qualify as Foundation sires/dams. Interested ow-
ners span the Continent & are growing each year. The breed is very versa-
tile & can be used for many various ways of riding. They are easy to train
& there have been many 2 yr. old National Perf. Champions in the ranks. Of
course they adapt to other training as well, and cow savvy & jumping are
just a few of their abilities.

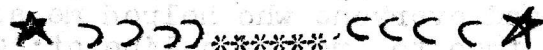

GRRRIPESS!! "In reading the Grippes column I've come across complaints concerning excessively long & difficult names on model horses, crummy show ribbons, high entry fees, etc. However, there is ONE of greater consequence--the showholder who refuses to return pix/awards in a reasonable length of time--or who just doesn't return pix at all! I am not referring to delay & loss caused by the Post Office or unfortunate personal occurrences which necessitate delay in pix returns--I mean those persons who deliberately keep--steal--pix or hold onto them for unreasonable lengths of time. Most of us have a great deal of time, effort & money tied up in our show pix & cannot afford to take the substantial loss occasioned by theft. I feel that pix should be back in the owner's hands within 2 weeks after the show date & that the show should be planned w/ that in mind. No excuses are really valid: with proper planning, awards can be made or bought well in advance & time set aside specifically for the actual judging. Aside from the moral issue involved, & the fact that many shows are missed when pix aren't returned, this practice strikes at the very heart of our hobby! What's the use of showing if you can't plan on getting your pix back promptly, if at all?..Not everyone is always aware of which showholder's shows to avoid, but if enough people enter a show & fail to get their pix returned, word gets around. Therefore some form of public punitive action should be formulated. Perhaps publication..of a **DEWARE** list of those who habitually hang onto pix overlong & those who are **KNOWN** pix-snitchers (thieves)...Happily the vast majority are honest but there is no reason why they should suffer at the hands of the unscrupulous, who, if they cannot play fair, should not be allowed to play at all." Signed, 'A shower... ED.This is fast becoming the major problem in the show world. Because of the Law, we cannot run a list of known pix snitchers due to being slander. Therefore, that is "out", but word does get around pronto in the show world as to what to avoid & where. Showholders. keep your reputations' clean. get pix back fast, hear? Thanks!!

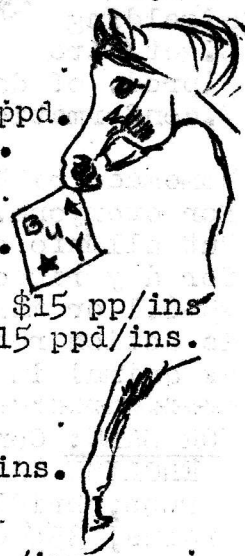
