MHSJ MODEL AUCTION: NEWS! We have about 50 models now consigned, and I'm looking for more. I will accept models' info up to & thru July 10th. The bids will be due by Aug. 30th unless the July issue carries a different date. The list of the models will appear in the JULY copy--reserve yours NOW. So far we have Hartlands, Breyers, unknowns and maybe to come in, a Bes. or H-R or two. Let's hope so! Many thanks to all the folks who've so far consigned models--I appreciate it immensely! If YOU want to hurry & consign a model, send this info to me by JULY 10th: 1. model's name, 2. sex, 3. breed, 4. age/date foaled, 5. sire/dam (if any), 6. make/model number if known/full description, 7. condition model is in (if broken, state where & repairs), 8. any pix (how many color, how many bl/wh.), 9. state LOWEST price you'll take, excluding postage, 10. your full name & address, 11. you agree to sell to highest bidder & if model does not sell you do not owe the 10% of the fee paid to the MHSJ, 12. sign your statement...That's all! You may meet the set price, go over or way over it, but not under it when bidding. If you are high bidder, you'll be notified (also if outbid). The highest bid received will get the model. Send no money anywhere until you know you bought the model. Terms may be arranged between bidder & seller, but that must be your own working out. Buyer sends the price bought the model for to the seller & 10% of the selling price to the MHSJ. Model must be sent within 14 days after the notification of selling or contact by the buyer. The MHSJ will not be responsible for models or cash lost in the mail. Duplicate high bids will be scrutinized & highest bidder w/earliest postmark gets model. I hope some more of you will try this set-up. It is the first time for the MHSJ to attempt such as this, so hang in there & WE'LL TRY HARD TO GET THINGS RIGHT! A new note here: Bids will be handled by Miss Kay McCue, 1105 Catalpa Dr., Middletown, Ohio 45042, not I. You should send all bids to her along with SASE so that you will know if you got the model or not. Send two SASE's & she'll let you know fast if you are outbid on the model of your choice. All models are acceptable for the auction, and all bidders are welcome, MHSJ readers or not. If I have left out anything, will pick it up in the JULY issue. Reserve your issue as soon as you can so that I'll know how many to print up. I hope all goes well, because if this works & makes us some loot, we'll try more later on. Thanks again, and hang on--we'll try to sell your model!

I'M receiving questions every day--super! Keep them coming! I'm answering your questions personally & then using them in my column as they come to the help of others also. That way you don't have to wait so long for an answer. Q#1. "How do you advertise a stal. or mare for service?"..A. You can either write in to the Mare or Stal. for Hire column in the MHSJ or write up your own advertisement. Put in such information as the age, color breed, molder, winnings & base your fee on either the winnings or the quality of your model. The fee can be given in either money or an amount of stamps, & they are usually 50¢ or less (but of course they do get higher in the case of an exceptionally qualified model). When someone uses your stal. or mare, you send them back a Breeder's Certificate for their foal, containing info on the sire/dam, & the foal's age, breed, etc. These can be of any design & I use a typed index card. You can look into some horse magazines & copy off original breeder's Certificates & use them as patterns.



#2. "How small are mini Hagen-Renakers, adults & foals?" Their mini adults run usually 37" tall to the eartips, & their foals are about 2" tall to eartips. The detail in these mini models is really amazing! The mini-mini models run approx. 10" for the adults to 1/2" for the foals! But they are scarce..If you have a question, one that has been bugging you, send it in to me! See you next month! Bye...

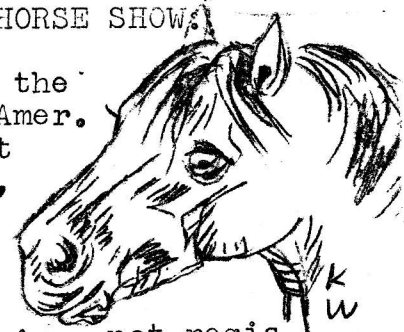

Only regular halter, Morgan hal, act., & stand. conf. count as qualifying classes for halter, & only Hunter classes count as qualifying classes for Hunter.

ENTRANCE PROCEDURES: The horse's full regis. name, number w/a sheet stating the show, date, showholder, class, placing, & no. in class w/entry fee must accompany nomination. The sheet stating the information about the show at which the horse won his qualifying placing must be by 3 vouchers signed. The pic may accompany the nomination or may be sent before Aug. 25th. If the nomination is not accompanied by the pic, a small SASE must be sent so that a show & class pass may be sent to the owner. All nominations made after JULY 20th are subject to a penalty fee.

FEES: 60¢ PER horse/class or \$2.70 per stable. All nominations before July 20th will have 10¢ per single nomination or 20¢ per stable nomination refunded. We have to order the ribbons by the 20th, so we want as much money as possible in by then to pay for awards. Last day for pix/nominations is Aug. 25th. Send large manila SASE. -27-

Variations can be made of the model's parents' names. In Arabs, BINT is\* for daughter & IBN for son in front of either parent's name will solve the problem. There is a right name for every horse & finding it can be easy. All it takes is a little imagination."..Ed. So right! I know most of you adore the real horses bearing such names as Kelso, Secretariat, etc., but think, wouldn't another name do just as well? Whoever saw Secretariat under Western tack in a WP class? REPAINTS & REMAKES Nancy Moses, 36 Hering Rd., Montvale, N.J. 07645

Sorry I missed some, will try not to let it happen again. Please hold off on write-ups as I've enough to last quite awhile! This time we have Jan Snyder to tell about her beauty & the work on it: (outdated, but good) "GLORFINDEL is a gr. roan Arab stal. w/real wh. m/t. The rep. mold is the Grey. PA stal & his parents are both owned by Bellhaven Meadows. The sire is Gr. Ch. Ingold Englorian & his dam is Gr. Ch. Angel if Destiny. 'Glory' began showing on April 28, 1973, & since then has won 1st-2, 2nd, 3rd-3, 6th-5; 7th-2, 8th-2, 9th-2, 10th, Hal. Ch., & is currently showing at halter, EP, Park, WP & harness.

"I've had many questions about HOW I painted Glory, so I've decided to tell you here so all you in MISSJ-land w/paintbrush fever can try it. Two basic colors are used, wh. & very dk. gr. Place a puddle of wh. & a puddle of gr. opposite each other on a sheet of paper/cardboard, grab a sponge w/many holes in it (a soft one) & mix the paints on the sponge so that you have a lt. gr. in the middle, wh. on the side & dk. on the other side. Then grab your model & sponge the colors over his entire body. Later on you can add shaded areas that need more wh. or gr. with the same sponge. This technique is best used on a white model!



"I show & sell other rep. models too. The paint I always use is a ceramic brand called Afrikaans. It can be purchased at most ceramic shops that sell greenware or bisque ceramic pieces. If anyone can get this paint, I'll be happy to send you specific instructions on how to paint the various horse colors. To give a model shading in the muscles, etc., apply a complimentary coat of paint over the basic color of the horse & wipe it off w/a rag. To do this, thin the color you wish to shade with by mixing water or oil. Then brush on a small area at a time & wipe it off w/a damp cloth (flannel or old sock is best). Be sure to apply your shading in only small areas at a time as the paint will dry quickly. Blk. stockings & noses on bay horses can be shaded on w/the fingers. Blend the blk. into the bay by dabbing w/your fingertips so that no distinct lines are seen. The same can be done for blending gr. stockings on wh. horses.."

Thanks, Jan! He sounds like a gem, and all that helpful info--GREAT!! See you all next time with another fabulous repainted model.
