

Marney reports some are wrongly labelled ! She wishes you to drop them a note & tell them to change to make it worth their while to change them: Stand Arab stal. as Citation, Prancing Morgan stal. as Arabian Stal., & lying TB foal is the lying Arabian foal. Otherwise the others to date are correct: TB mare & standing foal, Arab mare & Saddlebred. One source of info says the STABLEMATE series (minis) come in: Arab stal/mare=dap, bay, alab...TB mare=bay, blk, chest., foals same color. Sad,=dap. & bay. It's free!... COVER MODEL is closed fast all of 1975; Will have to be doubling up on the front & back covers before too long due to the response received. Thanks ! . . . After sitting down with pen & pencil in hand and figures of costs, it has become ALL TOO CLEAR that at the present sub/ad rates we are going under fast. Did you know it takes 3 weeks of hard work & nearly \$200 to put out ONE ISSUE at 56-58 pages to 525 people? Yup, 'tis true; Your ads are being brought to 500+ people EACH MONTH, and when you think of the cost, it becomes clear you are getting a bargain. After much debating and thought there's no way to lower rates, not even to the half-page, etc. rates I was hoping for, For the next month at least we'll stay with the current rates, but come late April/early May, we will go up. It may mean fewer ads, but then that ! 11 be fewer supplies to contend with, and possibly no raise in sub rates for 1975, or at least until late 1975. I hate it, as you do, likewise. But increasing pressure, economic & parental, has made this a fact, one that is MOST distressing and upsetting. So hang in there & bear with me. .. . Salary: The proposal I made last time has met with nothing but praise, thank heavens! So I will take a bit each month to pay me back for the long hours of work. Regretfully the ever-increasing work load means I must stop answering letters seeking news/indentification of your models, sources of models & catalogs, selling some catalogs xeroxed & the likes. Please, unless it is a dire emergency, do NOT write. Also I cannot help get pix back from shows, models from people, etc. I've NO way & can only sympathize. In other words, good luck & you're on ya own.

CHATTER, GROWLS & SNARLS: Please, no SASE, no reply to almost any thi thing. Am simply dumping letters asking questions & not enclosing at the least a stamp or 10¢. Speaking of which, do NOT send me Canadian money for ad, sub, etc. fees. It costs too much to get it exchanged hereabouts When sending in something, please check doubly sure you enclosed the fee the ad takes. Several people forget each issue & it delays their ads & my lay-oùts. Also tape down money flat, not in a lump, because sure as my typing fingers wearing out, the postal systems will scrunch it up.So take a little time & save money, effort & time for us both, thanky!..... The deadline dates again in case you might have missed them on page two where they always appear, they are: APRIL ISSUE: Feb. 28th..MAY ISSUE: March 15th. I have good reasons to get issues out earlier, so please oblige & do your part? Thanks ... Our nice home-run covers-might soon be 'disappeared' because the machine I use is being sold. Anybody got \$1200 to blow on an electronic stencil cutter? Ha, thought not, but as long as the shop keeps the machine, then I'll use it. If it goes, then that's it for photo covers, alas. . Several people have asked to go back to the professionally printed covers, to which I replied, NO. They cost like the dickens and we just cannot go it at today s high prices. Thanks to all who have given good advice and thoughts on how to improve the MHSJ look, but without money, we must remain as we are. I've sunk too much of my own money into it as is now, so either it survives & pays for itself on ad & sub fees, or ... Single copies: Many people prefer to buy them this way, one at a time, but then they get mad if the issue they want is sold out. Well, to complicate matters worse (?), I discovered that the late arriving issue buyers are paying absolutely no 'profit' into the kitty by buying late issues & having them sent not on the bulk seal. What it all boils down to is this: If the money is not received in time for the initial mailing (the bulk mailing), then they will automatically be jumped to the next issue to go out. You can avoid this by lesending in several weeks in advance of the month you want the issue for, 2. buy a larger subscription, 3 send extra money with copies for the extra 3rd class mail costs. How to gauge the issues! mailing? Well, the deadline usually is ' best. Within 5-10 days after the deadline, you can still get that issue, but after that, probably not. In all honesty, people, I figured the total cost & it came to 1-3¢ 'profit' on each copy mailed out late not on the bulk scal!! That cannot continue. Camadian readers, since I cannot mail on the bulk seal to you likewise, the page 2 info on extra fees applies to you, and I must add now, regretfully, that your single issues will cost from now on 75¢ to cover the extra postage costs. So, remember, if you want a certain issue, either get the money in weeks in advance or at least by the issue deadline. It'll work if you'll think & take a bit of time & effort to help my job become faster, easier & better for ALL.

THE TACK CORNER Carrie Wilpolt. 60 Seat Elrod, Oakland, Calif. 94618. Hi faithful fans; You'll be glad you tuned in this time when you hear from Cindy Fiszer & some good stuff. She makes tack for her small-sized horses using thin cardboard such as off a Sears catalog cover or cards used in pantyhose packages. It's supple & bends/works fine. First cut out the fenders. Hold them up alongside your horse's sides to measure the length between them, Cut out a Teather der tab & use it to paste the fenders together. Cut out a seat & paste it on top over the tab. Now make a ? stirrup leather & put it under the flaps pasting it, was & then paste another strip of paper as shown below to make it look like excess leathers. Next make a girth holder (as she calls it) on the offside & paste the sides of a paper strip behind the off fender, leaving the middle part across the fender open so the girth can sli slide under it. There should be a small piece of the girth left over after you slide it under the holder, You should fold this down & then the saddle will stay in place. For stirrups use thin wire or paper clips bent into shape, For the sad, pad, old sheets/pillow cases, etc, work girth Slides fine. Some old bedspreads have a cotton-like backing ununder holder (off side) derneath which is held in place w/cheesecloth-like material. How do you choose Champions at a show? Real horseshows go about it in 2 different ways. After judging the classes at your show, bring out the pix of the 1st & 2nd place winners from the category you wish the Championship to be awarded in (halter Ch., halter classes, etc.). Then the Champion is picked as the best horse among those presented. A Res. Champ would be the 2nd best of the group. A second & very popular way to select a Champion is by adding up points the horse has accumulated in the show. You can use a point scale to figure this & add them up as the horses place in the class: 1st=10 pts., 2nd=9, etc. Then the Champion would be the horse winning the highest number of points in his category. The Res. would be the 2nd highest number of points. Grand Champions are the outstanding horses in the whole show or the ones accumulating the highest no. of pts. in all classes entered ... There aren't anymore handbooks left so please hold off on your letters. For those who have already written in I'm copying off an extra set that'll be ready soon. 


