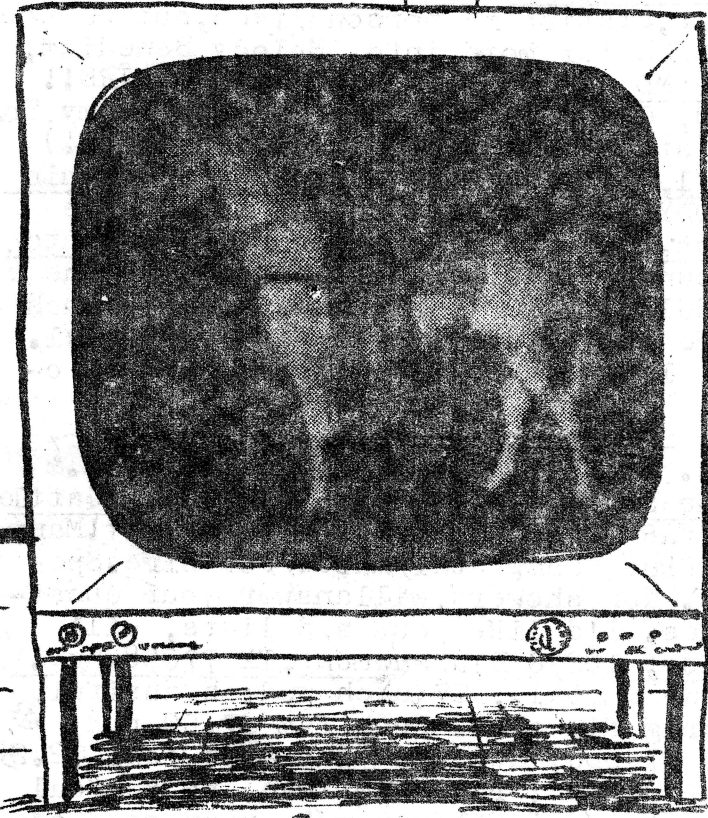

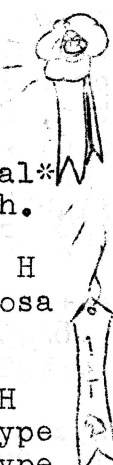

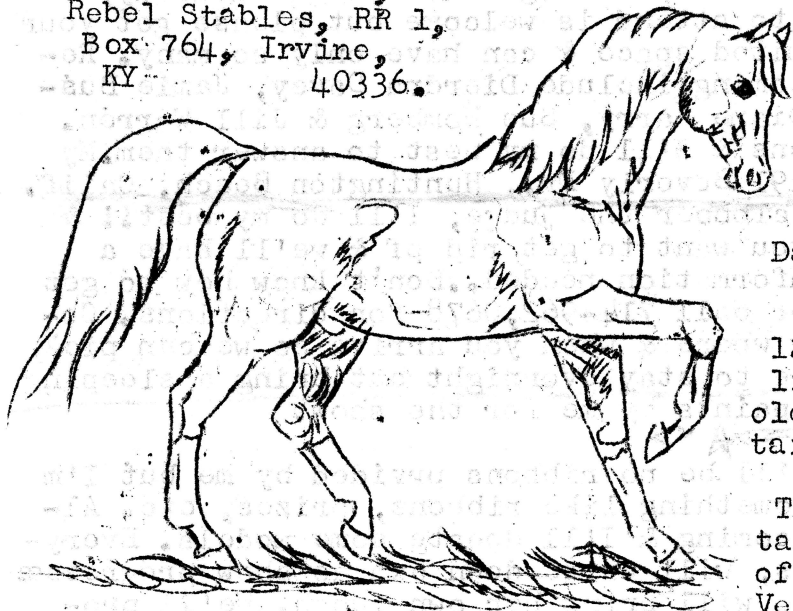

Hi! I finally got  a write-up on a super AA! He's owned by Kathy Kersh & is a 4 yr. old bay stallion molded by Shafford. Named AMBER HEROD, he's a 7" model sired by her own hunter stallion *Royal Master (TB) & hopefully will be foaled by Angelsey (Arab). He's an edium bay in color w/2 wh forefeet & a star. When shown he'll compete in halter, hunt/jump & hopefully Western events. He's one of only 2 A-A's owned by Kathy, but she hopes to get more in the future... Many thanks, Kathy! She also included this info which will help us identify some of our 'unknowns': Shaffords are a cross between a Beswick & a Lefton. Some, namely the Arabs, are Bes. copies but the rest are of Leftons. They combine the Bes. wh. forefeet markings w/the irregular Lefton markings (star) & sell for more than a Lefton but less than a Beswick! I have seen them in 3 sizes, 4", 5 1/2" & 7". (Ed. Those of you with the lying unknown-make foal & the standing TB like foal, this is the answer to your question as to what you own!). Thanks again! Shaffords are unique & quite unknown, so we were happy to receive this information. ++++++

 'All too often one sees a ridiculous horse that was 'supposed' to be cantering, yet looks as if 2 legs were tied to a rack & pulled. Make sure the work is realistic, or otherwise the money is wasted as the horse will not win. Do not accept bloated horses. If the remaker has made this mistake, he/she should be responsible to replace the horse w/a like model & complete the job to your satisfaction. All remad horses do not necessarily need to be repainted either, as many would lead you to believe. In fact, only in very rare cases is this necessary, such as in extreme fading. Small amounts of fading can be rectified by a quick coat of some protective art spray after the horse has cooled off. Don't pay for what you don't want! On hairing, make sure the hair is anchored well on the horse. There is nothing more maddening to have it all fall off. If you are dealing w/a reputable artist, your new model should come with a guarantee & some come w/lists of do's & don'ts as to what the hair/paint will stand up to. If you follow this list, the chances are you'll be well-pleased w/your next rep/rem purchase & will have years of enjoyment from it--hopefully along with many Ch/Res. ribbon for your walls...Noone is forcing you to pay the high prices & if you shop around there are models of equal quality to be had at lower prices."

OUR FIFTH YEAR IN MODEL HORSE SHOWING!!!!

Hard to believe, but that's right! In Jan. '71 after an article that appeared in the Oct. '70 Horse & Rider, Glengarry Stables became official & we entered the model world. We started off by joining the featured IMPHSA & MHRA--(both clubs now closed). We entered w/high hopes for our 80 orig. fin. Breyers & a Kodak instam. for pix. Those were the times when the combination of an orig. fin. Breyer & an instam. photo was a winning one & terms like 'remake' or 'Repaint' were never heard of. Of course the model world was smaller then too, estimated as under 500 people. Beswicks & Leftons were unheard of, Hartlands barely, & Hagen-Renakers could be ordered directly from the factory for under \$5 each!

The MHSJ, then the MSJ, was there too! My 1st copies were u/10 pages each & bravely typed out on carbons by a temporary editor & Linda Walter. Mostly shows & columns, the MSJ was mainly an open show bulletin as the clubs had bulletins of their own. Believe it or not, my own MHC bulletin used to rival the MSJ in size. We all know the other showers, & of course the horses that were written up in the columns, as we all competed against each other in the same few shows. Ads were lots cheaper & the cost of sending them around 2-6¢ stamps!

As I said we all knew each others' horses & some bulletins used to run questionnaires to see which horses were the most popular. Out of an early MHRA bulletin the most popular mare was Queen of Silver (Linda Walter), stallion *The Riff (Vickie Ordinetz), gelding The Witchdoctor (MAB), stable Bellhaven Meadows (Jan Snyder), etc. How many of you remember these?

The model show world has changed dramatically in these past 5 years, & while things cannot remain the same, some of the changes have been sad- dening also. However I do, & I think most all of the other old showers still around do too, welcome all of you 'Newcomers' into a hobby that many still laugh at. I was once told by a well-meaning woman that it re- mained her of her daughter's playing with dolls; but where else can one combine their love of horses into a hobby that, if they can't afford a live one, still join into the excitement of showing, breeding, etc. I think model showing has helped me in photography, art, writing, typing (don't laugh!)(Ed. Who, me?), advertising, almost a little taste of every- thing to come in life, especially learning patience & tolerance. Many people, including myself, started showing even though we already had live horses to take care of. Why? Well, for some it was because their live horse showing had been curtailed. For others...? Who knows why you take up something?...As for the future years of showing, people are people, & it takes all kinds to make up a group, model showing included. I think if we all try & remember that we are in a HOBBY & one where pride should be ta- ken in all respects, this may help. I'm not perfect & neither is anyone else. But at least we can try our BEST. (Ed. Right on!)

Back to Glengarry now. We started model dog showing in '73 & are again starting it. Our stable is ever-growing & doing well. I've added photo- graphy now & will take pix. 'Please, showholders, put in more Get of Sire & Prod. of Dam classes in shows! Most don't have them or have a 'Family' or 'Mare/foal' class, which doesn't earn points in MARA or most other clubs. All too often those who DO have these classes limit them to all the get/prod. in 1 pic, which is unfair for 2 reasons: 1. either you have to line them one behind the other or get far back (which means either way you can't really see the conformation of the get/prod), and 2. If you have 3 get of your stallion & 1 is a large Breyer, another a 9" Hartland, & 1 a 6" Hagen-Renaker, they are going to look silly & unrealistic if you put them all in the same pic! I've had several get/produce classes...and they are not all that much extra work with separate pix. Really they are more fun to judge that way...I know many other showers feel this way, too. AMD (Ed. Excellent points. Also if you don't own all the get of your stallion or produce of your dam, BUT have permission to show the outside get/prod. with a pic supplied by the owner, then what are you going to do? I have that problem showing the get of *Alconbury Hill, because 1 is a Hartland, another a Breyer QH Yrlg rep, and still another an H-R---none owned by me but sometimes shown in Get for the old man. Putting them all together in the same pic is impossible! So, please showholders, think & consider the points here. If the shower marks her/his pic CLEARLY as to who goes with whom, THEN the showholder might reconsider. Think about it, please?)
