OUR SHOWING WORLD Denise Nelson, 7010 Barton Rd., Roseville, Calif. 95678

Hello again! This time we're going to cover PARK classes. This is usually open to Saddlers, TWH's, Arabians & Morgans, although Hackneys & Pasos could also be used; decending on the judge. The correct tack is a full, double bridle (double reined) & a cut back show saddle. There are 2 different bits used: a Weymouth (curb & snaffle combined) or a Pelham (single

bit, can be a straight bar or a curb). The Tennessee Walker has a bit all to itself with 'S' curbed shanks & only 1 rein. The reason for the 2 reins on Saddlers, etc. is to keep the horse's head flexed at the poll & to yield with his lower jaw. This helps give the horse its beautiful head & flashy way of walking. The saddle is cut around the horse's withers to help show off the horse's chest & front legs & allows the high action & freedom of movement. An Eng. saddle cannot be used for Park as it was not designed for this. This class should be judged on tack, conf. of the horse, true action & overall appearance of fine performance. Spirit is a large part! (uestions? Need SASE for reply. Next issue: English pleasure/jumping. Tally-Ho! comments have come in recently on an earlier column. A girl recently saw a horseshow where they had an open trail class. Of 10 horses entered, only 2 were in western tack. A trail class is to show how a horse overcomes calmly, obstacles on any trail. YOUR flocked stallion has been in a fight with your repaint? The repaintwon & now your flocked stallion has a hole in his coat? What can you do? Read on, because this month's topic is on the care of a flocked model .. First, you make a trip to the nearest hobby shop & ask them if you can see their flock colors. Pick the one nearest to the original color coat as you can, & also pick up the following: small watercolor brush w/soft bristles & a bottle os Testor's enamel as close to the same color as the flock as possible. Now you are prepared to aid your model ... Stir the paint well, then apply it to the hole, matching edges with the rest of the flock. Do not use too much paint or it will soak into the coat & you'll have a nice, hard lump. On the other hand, if you use too little it won't hold the patch-flock. You'll have to work quickly as the paint will film over & won't hold the fiber. Now pour a pinch of flock onto the paint & pat it GENTLY. Leave it overnight & brush gently with a soft bristled brush in the morning. This will end a small wound, but if it's too big, only a new flock coat will remedy the matter...Got a flock problem? 'There's been alot of talk about 35mm pix, permitable colors, etc., but lately I've noticed in alot of shows...people don't have the vaguest idea of what they're supposed to be judging. Before someone holds a show & sets themself up as 'judge', they should know something about each model/real horse breed, especially in performance classes. Showers should find out what colors are permissible in what breeds & stick by them! The Palo. Arab may look good but no way should it be pinned over a bay. And in perf., know what type of work suits the breed. TB's almost always are better jumpers than Arabs, but an Arab is a costume horse & a TB isn't. TB's don't go in gaited classes! Nor should QH's, etc. Most breed information is available FREE from many real worse registries. If more people knew what they should before they hold a show, the right horses would get pinned instead of just the prettiest. . AS (Ed.Good points, bu' I personally feel that many of the young judges are doing fine jobs. A (Ed.Good points, but judge is stating an opinion in the shows, so what they choose is their way of expressing themselves. Keep on holding shows, people!) ***************

'This is a reply to an earlier Gripe. To the person who feels that a price of \$12.50 is too much for a rep. Breyer, even w/pix, I have this to say. Yes, \$12.50 is alot, but a Breyer costs \$6, right? Some are a little less, some more. People who rep. charge from \$1-\$8 & up! Add that on, plus \$2-5 for a hair mane/tail, also 12 pix, at least \$2 for film & \$3-4 for developing, and now you can see how the prices get up there! Also when you buy a model with a previous show record, you can expect that to cost, too, Those kind of models come w/10-35mm pix at times (not cheap either) ... It's the show record that made you want the model, right? Well the owner paid for that record in stamps/postage, show fees, registration fees, etc. Breyers that are Grand Champs sell for up to \$5011. In the real horse world this happens, so why not in models. You can't expect to buy a winner & not pay! Anon. (Ed. Right! Repainting takes time, too, & getting a winning model made up to show costs plenty. Model horse parents vs. real horse parents? One way isn't really hetter than the other. If you use real horse parents for your model & have a lengthy pedigree, be sure it is correct. Don't take a well-known horse & 'fake' in a pedigree for it! If you use a model horse parent, be sure you have permission in writing from the owner of the model! That paper allows you to say their horse is the sire/dam of your model, and it is good ONLY for that 1 horse... A word on naming models after real horses. Each time we have a Kentucky Derby winner, etc., there is a flood of models who appear with the name of that famous horse. Wouldn't it be better to settle for that horse as a parent instead of joining the flood? These names are the subject of confusion & many arguments among showers who end up naming their horses the same thing.

Now, I need some information from YOU! Does anyone know WHEN Breyer started putting their stamp on the log of the models? I know that their older horses such as the glazed finish Proud Arab (old mold) Arab mares, racehorses & old 'Fury' models do NOT carry the seals. Some of the family Arabs don't either, so we'd like to know approx. how old these models

are. Also, when did the glossy finish disappear from the lines?

Finally, if you have, or think you have, an H-R model & would like to know its number, model name, etc., you can send a picture & SASE & I'll try to identify it for you. Dear Fellow Model Horse Showers.

This letter is to ask for your help in saving our beloved American Wild Horses & Burros. The Mustang was placed under protection of the Wild Horse & Burro Protection Act of 1971, signed by Pres. Nixon. This protected them from being harassed by hunters in planes & other motorized vehicles. They were not to be sold to be made into commercial products. A few roundups were to be made occasionally to help the old & sick & help the population. All excesses were to be adopted by responsible citizens for care, or destroyed humanely. Not like the Idaho Slaughter. Since this bill horses are still being illegally rounded up for dog food. They are shot or herded from a plane or other motorized vehicles. Some are trapped & have a tire thrown around their necks & dragged by trucks. Some have their noses stapled shut for easy handling & some were loaded on a truck so they were really packed. Many were blinded. Can WE allow this to happen to OUR Mustangs?

To add to their problems, the Protection Act is being threatened. A congressman has introduced H.R.2935, H.R. 4470 & H.R. 4577, & a Senator has added S.1923. These bills will allow aircraft to be used to control the herds, This is giving horses a better opportunity to be shot from an airplane. The Mustangs will be transferred to individuals WITHOUT restrictions, meaning the slaughterhouse & no way to stop them from becoming dog food. (Ed.Some Wild Horses reportedly in Canada are being shipped overseas fas food for people! That came from a newscast I saw. GRRR!)

What can YOU do, you ask? We need petitions of all kinds. Get your friends to sign a list & send the lists along w/letters to Congressmen & Senators via me. I'll send them all at once. The sadder your letter, the better the chances are for the Horses. I feel that IF we get a large response, this is a sign the bills are NOT wanted. Please send letters. (Ed.Let her give you the names/addresses of the erring people. Due to space & certain reasons, I cannot run them here, but she does have them.)


