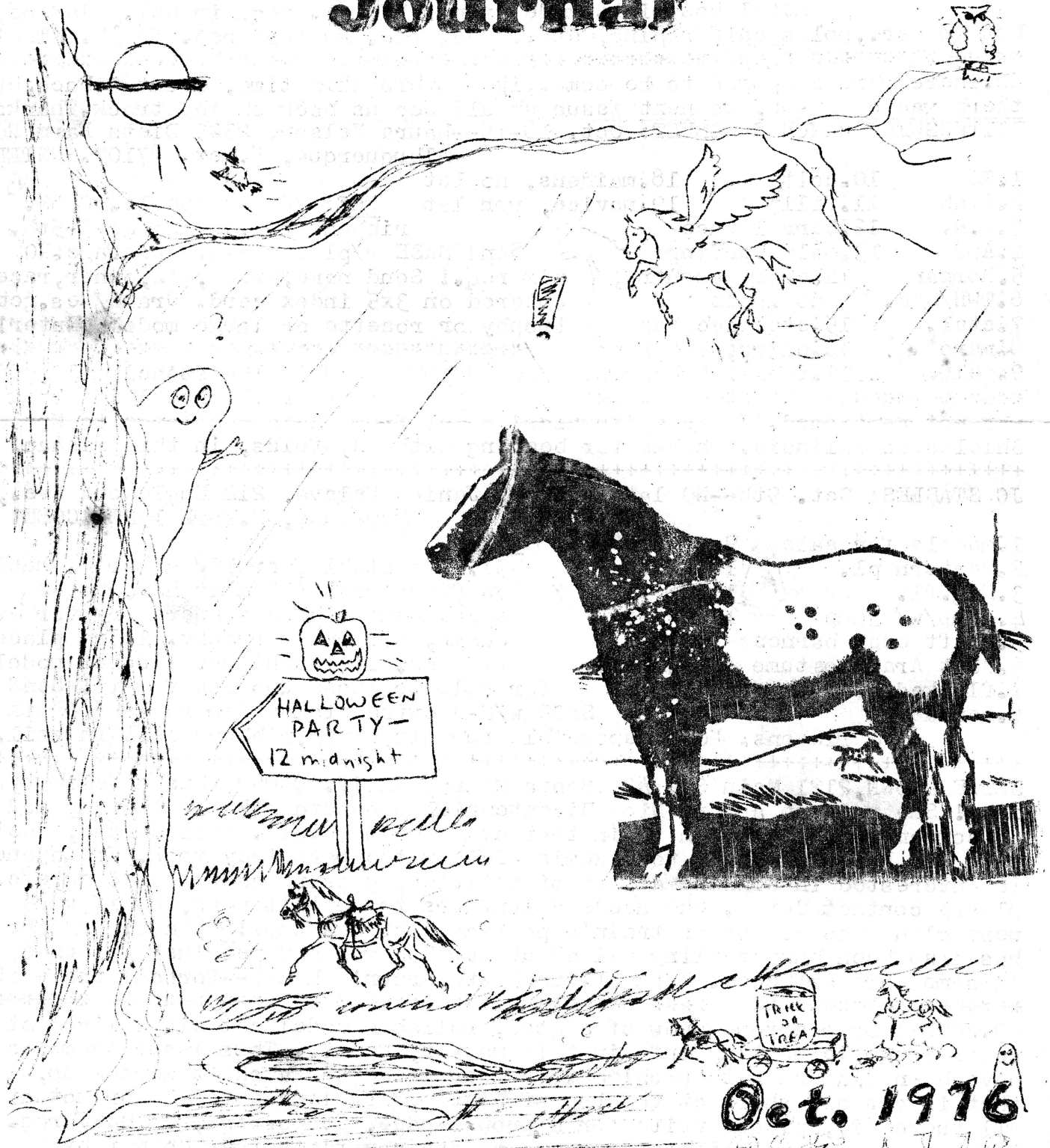

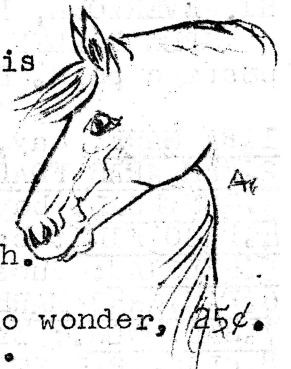
AD RATES! \$2 a classlist 1 page/under, \$2 stable ad 1 page/under, \$2 for long list of items for sale 1 pg/under, etc., NOT all you can cram together onto 1 sheet of paper. The \$2 fee means you get as much space as is required to run your ad, not necessarily a full page. I reserve the right to edit copy & reduce drawings due to our limited no. of pages/space. A 'mixed ad' is not acceptable, such as 1 classlist w/stable ad, 1 stable ad w/items for sale, etc. ONLY as much space is paid for will be filled with 1 ad. Ads are run as soon as possible, late ads subject to return to sender or will be placed in next issue or go in 'space allowing'. The SMALL ADS, such as happy birthday, congratulations, for sale of 1-3 horses, stal. at stud (1), etc. are run at 1-20 words=10¢, 21-40 words=20¢, 41-60 words=30¢, 61-80 words=40¢, 81-100 words=50¢. Limit 100 words. Do not count your name/address in the words. And do not round off the numbers. 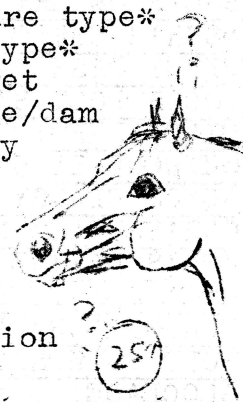

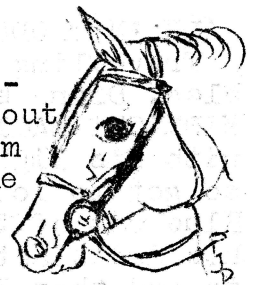

Q.=What do you do to enter a model in a Trail class? A=First, the showers are allowing more & more horses into such classes under English tack, & I think personally it's great. Now to get to the question, the Trail model ideally is one negotiating some sort of obstacles that might be encountered on a nice woodsy ride. It can be a series of logs to walk over or thru, a stream to cross, a trailer to get into, an 'L' shaped set of poles to back thru, a bearskin to sniff, a mailbox, a gate to open, etc..



Howdy! Welcome to our fall round-up! Jackie Nace of Tanglewood Stables just drove up so let's watch her unload. First out is RAGGAMUFFIN, a blk/wh tobiano Pinto mare. She is a rep/rem Breyer Indian Pony done by Bette Brown. This little lady came home from her 1st show with Grand Champ & Perf. Champ!..Another rep.rem by Bette is KEMO'S MOONRACER (chest/wh Pinto Brey.Clas. TB). Two wh. Arabs gleam in the sun as they step down the ramp. +++++ FLOCK DUST Ruth P. Diercks, 421 Main St., Bristow, Iowa 50611 29
 Today's fbck subject is the roan, which is a one-day operation & with modification, can be used in Appaloosas & is the basic action for the starting of a dapple grey. First paint the model entirely, except for the mane/tail, which if they are to be darker than the body color should already be flocked, & if lighter, should be done later. When the model is coated you should take it to 1 of the 2 boxes you'll have already set-up for this operation. The 1st box is the one with the color your roan is to be. The color should be put in the places where you desire the color to be, the overflow is your roaning, & don't worry about how dark it may seem. The second operation will usually lighten it & with some practice you'll get the hang of it. After you've put on the color, put the model into your white flock & spray the entire model, even the colored flocked areas until it has as full a coat as you might give to a solid model. When dry, dust out with a soft brush & finish by painting the eyes & hooves. This operation is for advanced flockers, but practice makes perfect! Got a problem? WRITE!

GRRRRIPES! c/o Linda Walter. Am getting some feedback, great! from the last column. Will get in as much as I can here & there.

'As to the colour of the hoof matching the colour of the pastern/leg above it, I agree with JM (Sept. MHSJ). It's true that the hoof on a wh. socked leg is not black but a paler colour. I have always painted my horse's this way BUT I wouldn't penalize a blk. hoof in a show. As real horse showers know, blk. hoof polish is sometimes put on non-blk. hooves to dress up a horse's appearance & the same should be considered in model showing. As to using clear nail polish as hoof polish, it really works & I've had lots of my horses' hooves dressed up this way! Can be removed w/polish remover, but who wants to!' A.P.. (Ed. I deliberately didn't mention that many show horses' hooves are blacked with polish, to see IF anyone else came up with that notion. Appaloosas aren't allowed to wear it I understand, but are there any others so-restricted?)

'People, when a stal. is gelded, he can no longer sire a foal. Lately it seems there have been several ads for stud service of horses gelded. This is impossible! Besides that fact, usually the reason a horse is gelded is because the breeder feels he is not of breeding quality. Why offer a gelded stud to the public even if this were possible! There are many top stallions available to the serious breeder, & had the stal./geld. owner just wanted another good showhorse, he/she could have left said horse a stud. They enter shows too you know...' D (Ed. Must comment. Not all geldings were inferior stallions, but many times an owner wants a 'safer' mount to ride, a good stal. makes a fantastic gelding, so not all geldings are poor stallions someone wanted to 'hide'. I believe the point in some of those ads mentioned was that if you wanted that model as the sire of your horse, any model older than he could have been sired by him. Since we deal with inanimate horses, it's 'possible' to go back in time, but I do see your point! Thanks for commenting!)

'I went to a racemeet recently & noticed 1 thing, almost all the horses that plac'd had a 'real horse' name! There were many Secretariats, Ruffians, etc. I never did mind much what people named their horses, but when showholders only place FAMOUS names, maybe we should pay a little more attention to such 'unimportant' areas of model horse showing! Second many of the horses today seem to show in EVERYTHING. Whatever happened to horses that just hunted? or just show jumped? or just participated in western events? or just pleasure? A horse that can race barrels, hunt, jump, show in halter, harness, roping, saddleseat & trail just isn't going to place as high as far as I'm concerned. If more showers specialized their stock, I'm sure they'd get more fun out of this hobby! Whether some folks know it or not, a barrel racer has alot different conformation than a hunter, and a hunter jumps alot differently than an open jumper! These things happen over & over again in shows & can ruin it for some people. A horse that doesn't place in work he is ideal for is very disheartening...' A (Ed. Good points! The name dispute will go on as long as we all show, but the other brings to mind something that happened to me recently. You all know my *Alconbury Hill, well, some anyway. He's entered in many English-type classes, NO western. His conformation is good for such, but he failed to win the Grand at a show recently because as the showholder put it, 'He doesn't have any western tack to show in so he can't be a really good horse!' Am NOT griping myself, just stating what alot of new showers get hit with, but what the showholder didn't take into consideration was that I don't care to show him in western classes as well as the fact he beat those horses who were entering into every class imaginable! So showholders, take that little thought to mind, & please, no barbs at your Ed. here, okay? Thanks. Oh yeah, some showers cannot AFFORD tack for classes, nor have the skill to make it. So show as you choose, but don't fuss at others for not showing in everything? My horses thank you, I thank you, the new showers thank you, and most of all, our Models THANK YOU. If he's good, he'll win, whatever.)

I have an answer from Breyer Molding Co. concerning 95828. =51= the Breyer stamp! Their letter carried this.. 'The Breyer emblem was placed on the models beginning in 1958 and in 1971 a USA mark was added for overseas mail.' So it seems the models that don't carry the Breyer emblem are older than 1958. I received a couple more questions about Breyer & have written them in regards about the following: who carves the horses for the molds & why do some of the models (mainly the Shire, cantering Welsh & Shetland Pony) carry the name 'C. Hess' on them, I believe this might be the person who did the carving. Perhaps he designed only the 3 models mentioned & a different person did the rest (Ed. Name is also on the 5-Gaiter). If anyone can supplement this info, please do so, & I've also written Breyer for the answer which will be printed here. Okay does anyone know what number is for the mare that appears with the 'Black Beauty' foal on the front of the Beswick catalog? Is she a Beswick or some other make? She isn't listed in the new catalog, just pictured on the front. She's gorgeous. (Ed. Can help there. The mare is the 'Black Beauty' H2466M black matt finish, 7 1/8" tall Beswick. She's possibly discontinued I'm told, but can anyone supply further info to us?) Thanks for writing. We'll cover other aspects of showers' questions soon.

Ed. Can anyone also tell us if other Breyers carry the 'C. Hess' name on them? The original castings of the Proud Arabians did NOT carry the USA much less Breyer emblem on them, so to tell if yours is a bonafide Old Mold stallion, mare or foal, look for NO seal/emblem. Hope that helps.

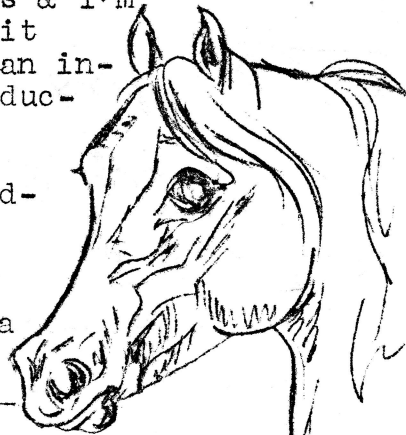

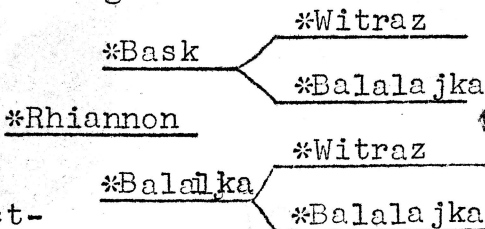

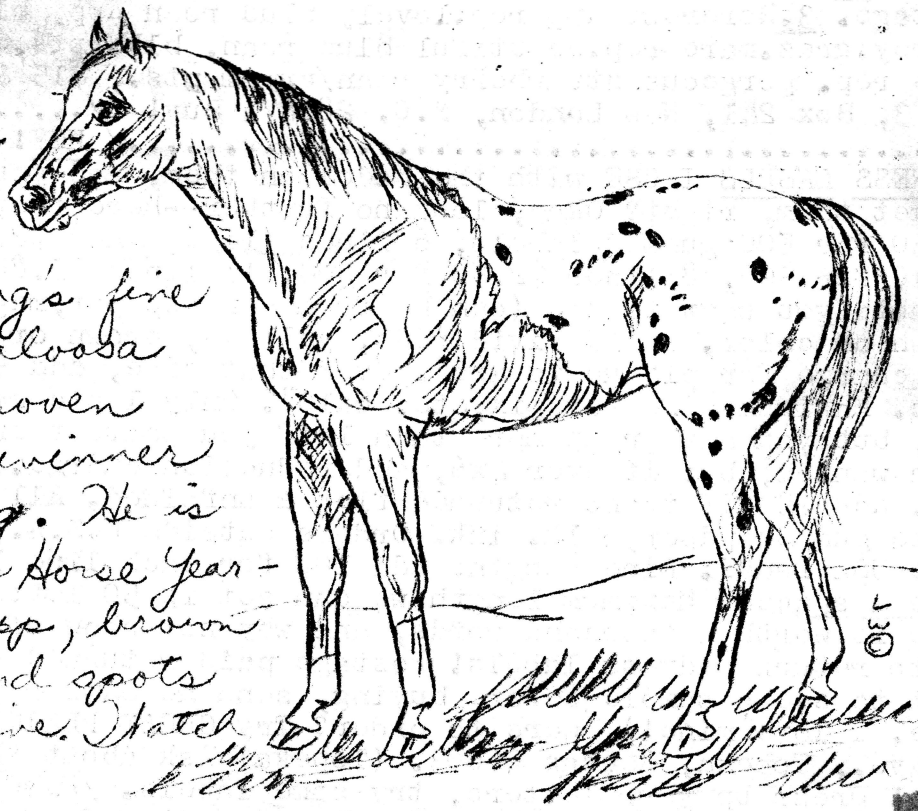
