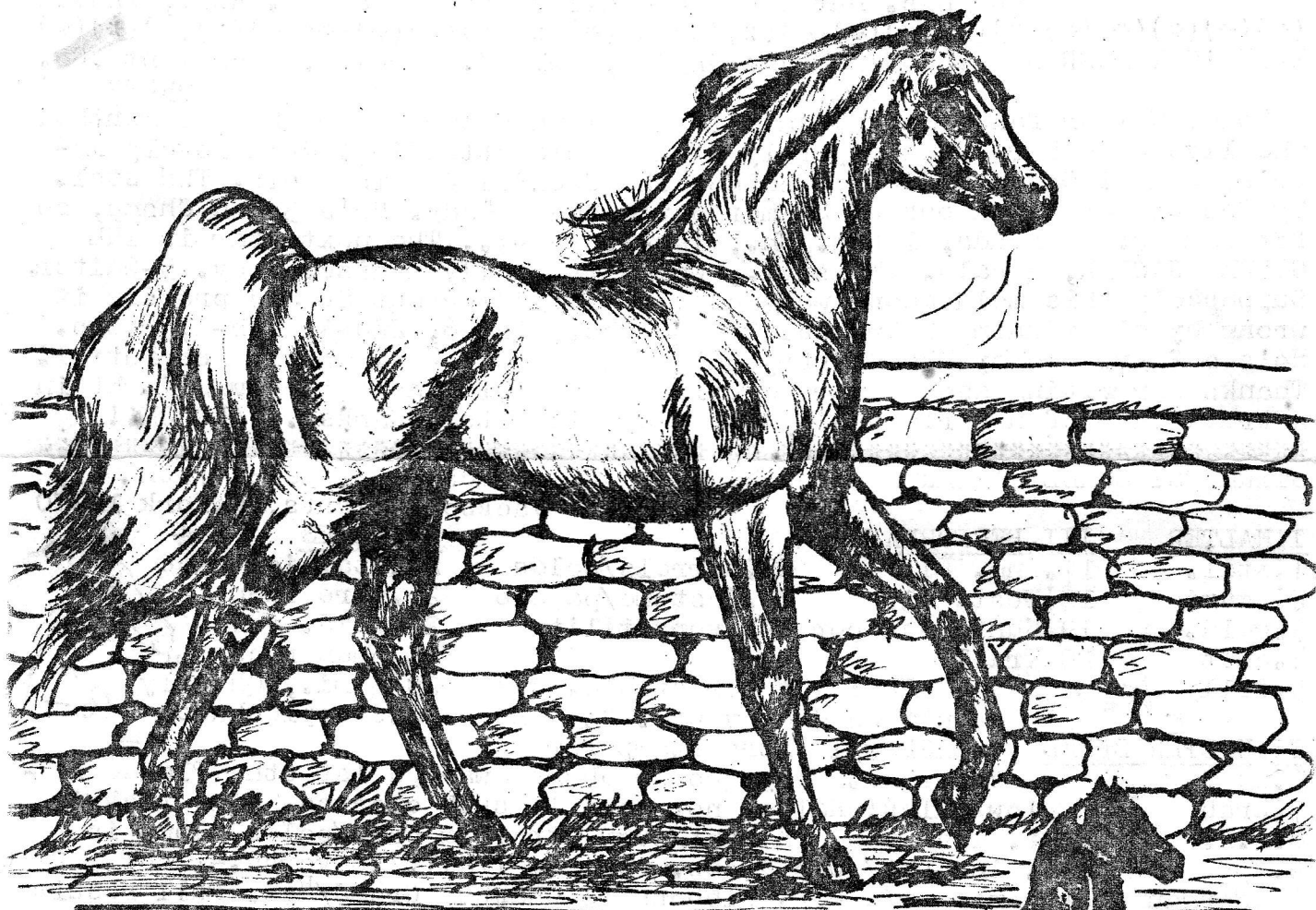


# The Model Horse Shower's Journal

Classlists=\$1.50 (per page, whether a full or only partial page), stable ads=\$1.50 (per page, etc.), long list of items for sale, wanted, traded=\$1.50 (per page, etc.). NOT ALL YOU CAN CRAM onto 1 sheet of paper. I reserve the right to edit copy due to the space limitations/materials costs. Putting 2 ads together: such as 1 stable ad & 1 classlist, 1 classlist & for sale ad, etc. is wrong. Only 1 will be run, as some will learn in this issue. Sorry! It costs anywhere from \$180 to \$200 to bring out an issue, so as you can see, ads play a very great part in paying for supplies. If you have an ad & are unsure of its costs, send it in to me w/SASE & I'll tell you the correct price. A few times people actually get money back! Small classlists of up to 10 classes & few rules may qualify for running at only \$1. Ask! I'm open to suggestions & want this to be your bulletin/magazine, but I cannot do it without your help. Thanks to all who've bought ads, written comments & otherwise introduced the MHSJ & showing to others. Hats off to YOU ALL!!

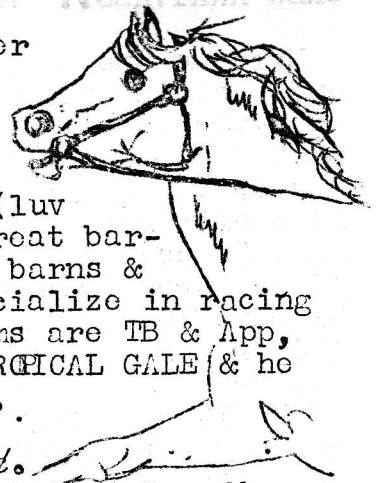

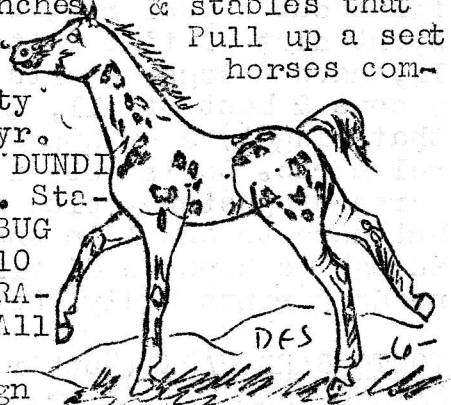

A real horsehide model eyes me as I zoom in for a close-up. She is a pretty blk QH named POCO PRINCESS...A quick visit to Julie & Jana Brumbaugh's Cheval Farms/Make Believe Farms enabled me to see 3 new horses. On the movie screen is a striking blk. 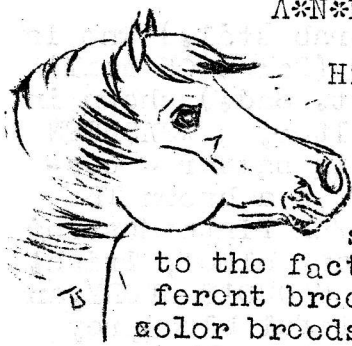

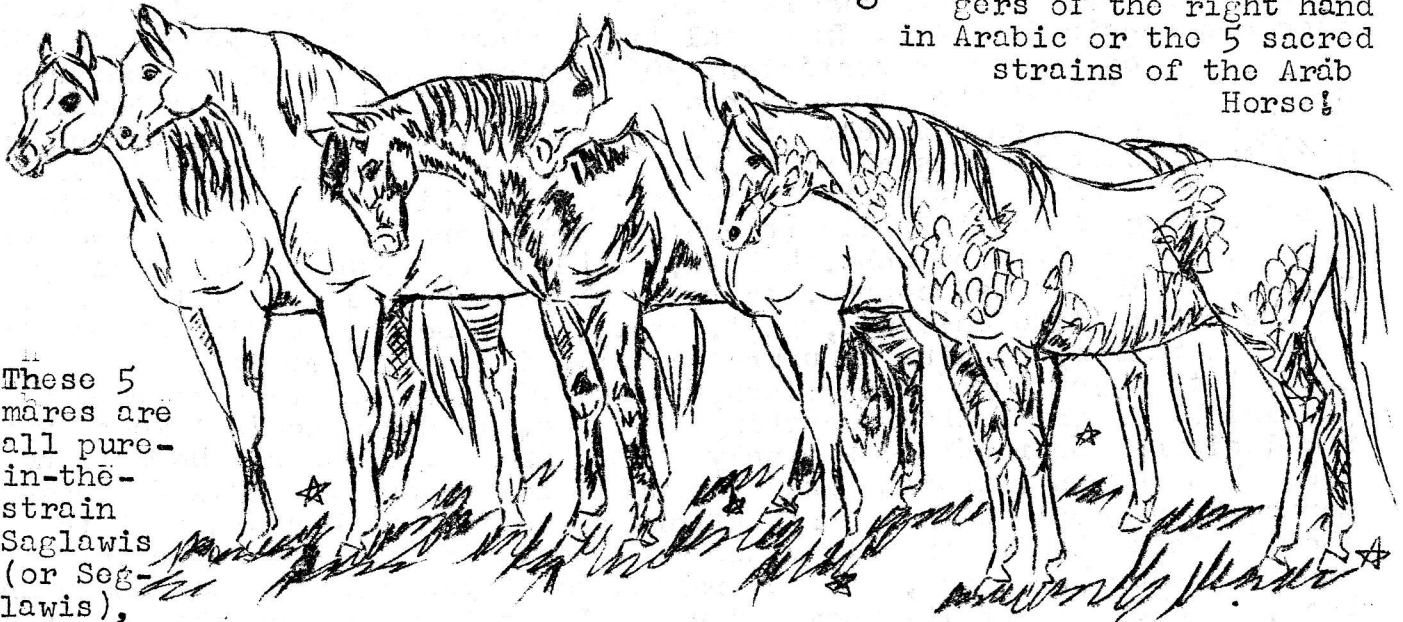

These 5 mares are all pure-in-the-strain Saglawis (or Seglawis),

three being of the very rare & most highly-prized Saglwi-Jedrans. Saglawi horses, especially mares, are very sacred to the Bedouin nomads. These 5 mares were all imported from Sudi Arabia in Nov. 1974 after much searching. We would like you to meet them now. They are left to right:

\*Moniet el Nefous (Shahloul x Wanisa) 1947... \*Köalicja II (Awaj x Federacija) 1957... \*Jādī 'Allah (Awaj x Khalfa) 1962... AK Moniet Ami (\*Ibn Moniet El Nefous x Alahnar Mon Ami) 1971... \*Al-'Arabiya as-Sa'udiya (Al Baheer x Kerima) 1961.

These mares are just an example of the top quality mares we will be adding to our broodmare band. They are now up for hire. 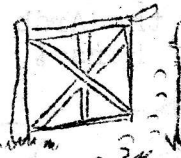

Hello again! This month we're going to talk about a class where obstacles are required: TRAIL. In a real trail class the horse is judged 60% on work over obstacles, 30% on trail work & 10% on conformation of the horse. Since we are showing models that can't move, an obstacle is VERY important, the more imagination, the better. This class should be judged on the horse's conf., the tack & what obstacle is in the pic. Listed are some of the things used in trail: (there are lots more) fence & gate, wooden bridge, water ditch or pond, 4 logs, hobbles or ground tying, backing through an 'L' shaped course, carrying objects from 1 end of the arena to the other (like chickens, pigs, etc.), mail boxes, leading a horse into a horse trailer, opening an umbrella, dragging a sack or log, many more! So next time you judge this class, remember almost any type of ranch work is alright in trail EXCEPT cutting & roping. NO Eng. saddles! These were not designed for ranch work & only belong in Eng. classes. There is no such class as Eng. trail. Take care until next issue... (Ed. A few comments. Many people either can't afford or don't have Western tack to show in this class, hence they use Eng. tack. As for horses working on ranches under Eng. tack, try Australia. So if you want to show under Eng. tack, go ahead & try it. Showholders, it's up to you to choose yay or nay on the tack in your classes, so have fun! See in those classes!)

WHEN TAKING PHOTOS...This is based on an article from the Sept. Arab Horse World magazine, 1971. Sent in by L.E. Thanks! It applies to us. Changes were made to make it apply to models....

1. The horse is a good example of its breed & looks it!
2. The horse is well-developed & well-groomed, dusted in our case.
3. Although standing still, the model shows animation. Ears & eyes are alert & all feet are on the ground (standing models only), the tail hangs well. Of course you can't re-do a model's tail unless it a remake or new one added, but they should be groomed & nice-looking & fitting of the breed.
4. The photo is not retouched in an attempt to improve the horse's conformation or appearance (no repainting on pic with felt-tip pen, pencil, etc.)
5. The background does not lose the model, uncluttered preferably, of a contrasting tone & texture from horse, stone works well!
6. The horse is not placed awkwardly, weight placing is evenly distributed, model does not look like it's getting dizzy & about to keel over!
7. To avoid the appearance of a short, thick neck, the horse's head should not be turned fully to the camera. Search through the viewfinder of your camera to spot the best possible angle to make the model's conformation the best it can be.
8. Aim the camera at the middle of the horse for correct proportioning. Pointing at the hindquarters will make the horse look heavy \*\*\* while pointing at the head will make the head/neck too heavy & the hindquarters too light.
9. Find the focal point of your camera to be sure your hard-earned, hard-taken pix are not blurred. Happy camera clicking!

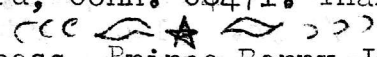

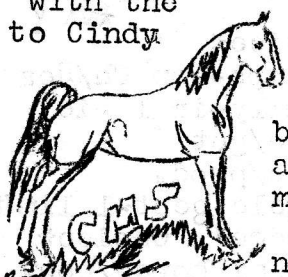

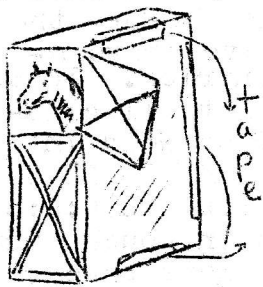

This month we have Kelly Dewsnup's information about preserving our pix. She says to buy plastic wrap used to wrap sandwiches in. Cut off enough so you can cover the front of your pic & the back w/o over-lapping much. Then scotch tape which you can write on is good to use on the wrap to hold it together. Then you can write classes on the tape & not on the pic. When the plastic gets dirty, just take it off & replace it. If you smooth out the plastic you can hardly tell it's there & your pix will hold up longer. Thanks, KD, for that top hint!



Another tip is on stall building. An easy way to stable your models is to save the Breyer type box your models came in. Set the box up on its side, tape the bottom to top after you've cut dutch style doors in 1 end, and you have a new stall to protect your fine model. You can take construction paper to cover it, draw on it with a magic marker or paint it to suit your whim. Also they may be stacked into 2-3-4 level barns.... Hi, App fans! This time we feature another bunch of Appaloosas. Did ya know that Hartland made several Appaloosas in their time? The first set came in grey of varying shades with white blankets (though some were in more of a leopard pattern) & blk points/spots. They carried the number 6003 & were 7" tall w/stal., mare & foal. A lesser-known App was a grey standing several inches taller than the Family set & carried #840. He's quite sought after now & some say he came with a rider. The last App is #9926, a blood bay with black points. He also appeared as a blue roan in the same mold, though not as commonly as the bay. Know of others? Write!

The Budjonny is a successful 'new' breed in Russia although little known here. In 1948 a military stud near Rostov created this horse by crossing the native Don Horse with the TB. With interbreeding, an agile, speedy & longwinded horse resulted. They make superb jumper having attained Olympic standards as well as top mounts. They are usually bay or chestnut with a golden overtone to the hair, & they stand approx. 15hh to 16.2 hh. Their limbs are clean & strong, with curved neck, deep, wide chest & body & a rather beautiful head. The overall effect is nicer than the original Don Horse & prettier than many TB's...Thanks, Cindi! The breed is not well known here, but now some folks might start showing them. How about it? Let's fill up those unusual breed/others classes!

First of all, let me qualify myself as a judge. I began showing live horses at age 12 in all aspects of western riding, went into English P. & equitation. From there I went on to 3 & 5 Gaited Horses, and finally, I switched to hunters and jumpers and belonged to a hunt club. I have also collected horses for over 20 years and have a knowledgeable background on such, especially the now horseshide ones....Now...I saw some very poor judging at a live show...One instance was in the Championship finals when a Res. Champ Perf. was to be picked. There were only 2 horses (not mine): a Lefton (no tack, not even a halter) & an H-R (nicely rep. in perfectly scaled West. gear). The judges picked the Lefton. I think great favoritism towards 'friends' was displayed. Another instance again was in the Championship finals when the judge narrowed it down to 2 geldings: a plain, orig. fin. Breyer Q.H. gelding App (no halter, no tack) & a prancing black horse in the most beautiful, handmade & realistic western parade outfit ever to hit the model ring. The outfit fit perfectly and surely must have taken weeks to make---the judges picked the Q.H. The obvious winner was left 'out in the cold'. Many people noticed the injustice but said nothing. People! If you judge, be fair!

Below is an outline I feel will help everyone who considers herself/himself a judge of a live show or otherwise. It took hours of deep concentration & thought:



1. Put aside 'Friendship' & 'Favors due'.
2. Look at every horse in every class.
3. Is he/she correctly entered? proper breed? proper tack?
4. Who really stands out like 'a sore thumb'? The truth is self-evident & there is usually 1 horse that is truly worthy of that blue ribbon. Do NOT be afraid to choose the obvious winner.
5. How much effort was put into the model? (A. Is it a good rep.? handmade? flocked? carefully remade? B. Is the horse 'fresh' from the store shelf? no halter? no effort involved in preparation?)
6. In tack classes, how much time do you think it took to make the outfit? (A. Is it realistic? b. Leather, plastic? c. Remember, studding & buckstitching takes tedious time & sometimes weeks to finish. Most of all, does it fit? d. Does the tack look good on the horse?)
7. Photos should not matter that much. Look at the horse/tack first. Then consider background/setting.
8. Painstaking effort in presenting a true team of horses & tack should be well considered. Remember, these are models, not real, live animals & should be judged as such!

I sincerely hope everyone will read this & keep this outline in mind whenever judging a model horse show. Thank you...Charmaine Shields

We're going to delve into horse colors, so off we go! A few things to note before descriptions are that model companies aren't always right about colors. Designations like alabaster & charcoal are not true horse colors. Alabasters are either white or lt. grey & charcoals are blk, & these should not be entered on 'other colors' on classlists....BAY: body color tan to red to reddish brown, mane/tail black, sometimes blk. on lower legs/ears, nose, etc. But not always!...BROWN: body color br. or blk. w/light areas at muzzle, eyes, flank & inside upper legs, m/t blk. & usually blk. on lower legs...SORREL: body color reddish or copper-red, m/t usually same color, never blk., but may be flaxen (light off-wh. hue)...CHESTNUT: body dk. red or red-brown, m/t usually same color as body, never blk., but may be flaxen...DUN: yellowish or gold, m/t blk., br., red, yellow, wh. or mixed, often dorsalstripe, zebra stripes on legs & transverse stripe o/withers...RED DUN: form of dun w/yel. body color/flesh-colored, m/t red...PALO.: golden yel., m/t wh....GREY: mixture of wh. & blk. hairs, ususally born solid-colored & gets lighter w/age...RED ROAN: MORE or less uniform mixture of wh. & red hairs..BLUE ROAN: more or less mixture of wh/blk hairs...ALBINO: snow wh., pink skin w/no dk. spots, m/t white, no dark hairs....Showers handbooks now available by sending 10¢ to: Andrea Pratt, 253 Stewart Rd., Lions Bay, B.C.
