





PLEASE, before you throw it out as an "RR prospect", consider whether it can be restored. I am interested in old and/or rare Breyers; they can be restored if they are in good condition but have a broken or missing leg; badly yellowed models can also be restored. I am willing to buy these models from you, or I can restore it for you; however, I don't guarantee my restoration work like I do my RRH's. Sometimes they can't be fixed, but it's well worth the time & effort to TRY!!!

### Hagen-Renaker Corner by L. Jensen

The "Two Bits" Quarter Horse stallion was actually released with two names: "Two Bits" and "Erin." This is confusing to collectors – "Erin" is actually the mare in this family set. The stallion was produced from 1959 to 1962 and was called "Two Bits." From 1962 to 1972 he was incorrectly called "Erin." He came in buckskin and brown, 1959 to 1972. He was re-released from 1983 to 1986 and came in matte and glossy bay. A special run of 25 matte palomino and 25 glossy palomino was manufactured in 1985.



"Two Bits" stands 5 3/4" at the ear tips. He originally sold for \$4.00.

#### SPECIAL TIPS FOR REALISTIC TABLETOP PHOTOGRAPHS - BY LINDA STURHANN

What makes a good model horse photograph and what makes your beautiful model look like just another hunk of plastic? The secret to realistic photos relies on your ability to fool the eye, to make the person believe he is looking at a real horse. This is accomplished with tabletop photography, the technique of making the scale model look like the real thing through attention to the details that give tabletop away.


A lot of the techniques mentioned in this article were learned from model railroad enthusiasts. If you are interested in learning more about the art of tabletop, there are many railroad magazines available. They have some fantastic ideas on making believable miniature scenes. You can create everything from a pine forest to the New Jersey Palisades to the sandstone formations of the Dakota Badlands right in your own backyard. All it takes is a little time and a little practice.

Tabletop tips:

- 1. Try to raise the surface that the model will be posed on. I use my picnic table. I cover it with a torn open garbage bag so it is easier to retrieve granular materials such as the "dirt."
- 2. It is always better to use a prop that is a bit too small than one that is a bit too large. Nothing makes a model look more like a model than something like a prop bale of hay that is as long as the horse.
- 3. Dirt or sand comes out looking like small rocks when photographed close up. Take a tip from the model railroaders and use old coffee grounds for dirt. Always dry them thoroughly by spreading them thinly on a cookie sheet and baking them in the oven for about 20 minutes at 350. Otherwise, they might stain a light colored horse or will mold if you try to store them. By the way, the best storage container for your dried coffee grounds is the can the coffee came in.
- 4. To simulate the sand or composition footing used in an indoor arena, use crushed kitty litter or the clay granules used in a garage to soak up grease. Place the kitty litter in a double garbage bag and roll it with a rolling pin. Crushing the kitty litter will break down the granules that may appear too large in the photo.
- 5. Brick walkways are easy to make around a barn area. Buy a strip of doll house bricks that come on a web backing. DO NOT separate the bricks, but use them attached to the backing. (The backing can be cut to fit a specific space. Just place them where you want your walkway. Press a painted strip of balsa against the side of the bricks. (It can be held in place with small pieces of clay). This gives the finished look that brick walks usually have. Next, pour salt into the spaces between the bricks; it photographs like the white mortar used with bricks. To be most effective, the walkway should not be photographed too closely, just sort of in the background, or the salt will appear too granular.
- 6. Try to keep any vertical backdrop far enough away from the model, that the model's shadow does not fall on it. Since you are trying to achieve the feeling of depth, a shadow that goes across the ground and up the front of the backdrop will only accentuate how close the backdrop really is.
- 7. Try to keep backgrounds somewhat neutral. The busier the background, the harder it is to see your horse. One of the best backgrounds I have found is the flat front of one of the evergreen shrubs in my front yard. It photographs like a dense pine forest and goes pretty much unseen.
- 8. Try not to photograph a dark horse against a dark background. The details of the outline of the horse tend to become lost. If this is a problem, try to reflect light on the horse with a piece of white paper, etc, to help define the lines. (See photo tip #11).
- 9. For close shots, wild bird seed makes a fairly good simulation of sweet feed.

- 10. Model railroad pine trees make excellent potted plants to place in front of stadium jumps.

  Anything that looks like a pot, either miniature buckets or even the tops for spray cans can be used to hold the trees. Place taller ones in front of the jump standards and smaller ones in front of walls or between the elements of an oxer.
- 11. Any piece of tack that does not lie flat or in the correct place can be adhered to the model with a miniscule piece of clay. Use a synthetic clay in white or a natural color. If you use a bright or dark color, it may stain a light colored model. Leave the clay on the model as short a time as practical.
- 12. It is easy to simulate a post and rider fence, either painted or stained (see diagram). Use the same balsa wood used in doll house construction. Three sections are usually enough to spread across the photo frame. The center section will have three upright pieces. Carefully tack thin scraps of wood to the bottopm of each upright so it will stand. Glue two pieces of balsa (1/4 inch wide) across the center upright and half way across the two outer uprights. Weight until dry. The two outer sections of fence only have a center upright and an upright on one end (the end without an upright will be placed against the upright on either end of the center section). Glue outer sections the same way you glued the center. Once everything is dried, paint or stain the fence sections. When the fence is in place in front of the backdrop, whatever you use as dirt will cover the flat piece of wood on the bottom of the fence and help to keep it in place.

We also have heard the sad news of the death of Christian Hess.

Christian Hess was born in 1913 in Chicago, and passed away on October 25, 1988.

He originally began as a woodcarver, and had his own company, Hess Engineering, which made building decorations (sconces, etc.). He had some art training at the Chicago Art Institute.

In 1950, he sculpted his first model for Breyer, the #57 Western Horse. The last model he completed was #435 Secretariat. During the 37 years that separated these two models, Christian Hess sculpted every model animal (including the wildlife animals) produced by Breyer except for the Maureen Love horses (the H-R copies) and the recent Artist Series horses. His name is carved into several Breyer models, including the 5-Gaiter, Shetland, and Shire.

Mr. Hess was also a mold maker for Breyer; he or his son Bud created the molds for every one of the Breyer models, even if they were not his own sculptures.

In addition to his work for Breyer, Mr. Hess did the original "Wonder Horse" model (the large "springy" riding horses.

He is survived by his wife of 50 years, Elizabeth, and their four children.

We will all miss the work of Christian Hess, but his art will live on for many years in collections throughout the world.

# REVIEW OF THE BREYER SIGNING PARTY/MODEL HORSE FAIRE or

How to Go Insane with A Little Help from Your Friends

The planning of this year's signing party at Black Horse Ranch began months before the actual date of September 24th. A new, umpteen square foot building was constructed with the entire upper floor housing the 3500 plus collection of owner Karen Grimm. Several of us (Heather, Lani, Cheryl, Sheryl and me) spent nearly every weekend for the preceding month dusting, moving, tagging, pricing and worrying. Invitations were sent out to several hundred people, many who have never met other collectors. One woman dragged her husband along to prove to him that she wasn't crazy—there were other adults involved with this hobby.

Last year's event had over a hundred people (probably a whole lot more but we run out of sign-up sheets). This year nearly two hundred and fifty with collectors attended with some coming from Northern California, Arizona and even Texas and Connecticut (although I must confess the last one heard about the signing party while visiting relatives here in California).
