Ah. Now to attack the stack. (Kay here - I'm sorry...is that "stack" or "Stack?" I would guess it is




this...)





We apologize for the delay last issue - December is the busiest month of the year in my office, which combined with our faithful printer being closed when we finally got everything together put us really behind schedule.

Anyway...thank you to all who had patience with us. I would also ask that if the Rag is late getting to you and you are concerned that the issue was not mailed to you, please contact Heather, not me. Once the issue is formatted and ready to go the printer, it is sent to Heather, who gets all of the copies

made and mails it out.

On another note...if anyone writes to me requesting a response prior to the next issue being compiled, please write "RESPONSE REQUESTED" or something similar on the lower left corner of the envelope. Two issues ago, the Rag Bag put up several "model lore" questions to our reading public. Here are the responses we received for two of them:

1. Q: What Breyer animals came on lamps?

- A: From our various contacts, we have heard of the following: Longhorn in woodgrain (see S. Rowe's ad last issue!), Running Mare and Foal in both woodgrain and bay, Brown Bear and Cub, White Poodle, Fighting Stallion in woodgrain, FAF in woodgrain, and the 5-Gaiter in sorrel with eyewhites. In addition, as noted in this ad from Western Horseman (January, 1972), the Western Prancer was also a "lamp horse." None of the lamps were made by Breyer; they were all produced by other companies. Most had the same basic stand, pole and shade, although we have also seen some wall lamps (with woodgrain Running Foal). Some that have been seen were home made; one man in Del Mar makes a lamp that has a fence with a Classic TB model on it.
- Q: What is the difference between the "Old Mold" PAM and today's?
  The Old Mold PAM was produced from 1956-60 in glossy bay, alabaster, grey appaloosa, and (supposedly) palomino. They were discontinued in 1960 after a lawsuit was threatened by H-R. In 1970, after the PAS was introduced, the PAM was brought back into production. Unfortunately, it was discovered that the left side of the mold was missing and had to be recast, and the "cooling boards" for both the mare and foal had to be redone. As a result, the later version of the mare toes out, and the foal's front legs are



You've probably all heard about the upcoming Breyerfest 1990 to be held at the Kentucky Horse Park at the end of July. At the charity dinner, they will be giving out a special model, "Dr. Peaches", #803 in bay. There will only be one per person available. Proceeds from the dinner will go to save the Misty of Chincoteague Park, and Marguerite Henry will be a special guest. The Model Rag will (hopefully) be represented at the festivities by (drum roll!) Kay, who will be bringing her un-model husband all the way to Kentucky on his birthday no less! Gosh, what more could he ask for!

Breyer dealer catalogs will be available later this month, with the new consumer catalogs coming out in March. Several of the new models are already hitting the streets, but the new Khemosabi and Roemer molds will be the last ones out.

For some details on the new colors: The Blanket Appaloosa mold is being done in 2 colors this year one will be a Bay Blanket Appaloosa, and one will be a palomino (not appaloosa); the Palomino will be called the Comanche Pony. The Brenda Breyer #498, #499 and #500 are being discontinued; she will no longer be available in western, English, or denim outfits, but she is coming back in a Dressage outfit and a show jumping outfit! The American Mustang will be a black and brown and white Paint. Also, there will be new blankets and shipping boots in the 1990 Breyer line. Thanks to Jody H. for filling us in on all the hot news!

News from the H-R front as well...Heather went to a dealer's gift show, and got to see some of the neat things that H-R has in store for us. First was the new mini horse, about the same size as the postage stamp horses. This one is grey/white and is trotting "kind of on its haunches." Should be ready in the fall, if we're lucky. Also there was a 4" Seahorse on a coral base, done in a "Luster finish," i.e. iridescent. They also had a Mermaid in the luster finish, as well as a giraffe in Stoneware, lying with its head up, about 5" tall in a brown with gold/orange spots. H-R is also re-tooling the Lion. Heather said the H-R book was being sold at the trade show - good job!
