Wow! Things have been so busy that I know I haven't had time to look for anything. Luckily some of you haven't had the same problem.

While at the Western Regional Congress a few weeks ago, Lynn Lindgren of Arizona told me of her great find. In answer to an ad, she went to see a woman who said she had a number of old Breyers. There wasn't anything spectacular but then the lady mentioned that she had some ceramic "fat-necked Arabs" in the next room. Turns out these were the Hagen-Renaker palomino Morgans--Monrovia no less. Lynn picked up 7 or 8 DW sized HRs and about 15 minis! It was the largest find of HRs in one place that she'd personally had.
Speaking of WRC, there was lots of wheeling and dealing at the show. At least two collectors have decided to get out of collecting and brought quite a few models to the show to sell.
