to fall into beer.


While waiting, drink the rest of the beer and finish off the dip and chips.

She has sent some clippings from the "Equestrian Connection" magazine:

"...The 1985 *AMBC North American Livestock Census* shows that a small number of breeds now dominate the scene while 80 minor breeds are threatened with extinction....the following is a partial list of *AMBC* breeds:

Watch: Breeds whose registrations over a 25 year period have shown a steady decline or less than 5000/yr; American Cream, Belgian, Percheron.

Minor: Less than 1000 registrations/yr; Spanish Mustang, Hackney, Gotland

Feral: Stock known to have been running wild for at least 100 years without introductions of outside blood; Wild Mustang

Rare: Less than 200 registrations/yr; Bashkir Curly, Spanish Barb, Cleveland Bay."

Also...some interesting points on statues of horses and riders: A horse standing on all four legs with rider mounted designates the rider to be a "National Hero." A horse with three legs on the ground with rider mounted indicates that the rider died as a result of injuries suffered in battle. A horse with two legs on the ground and the rider mounted indicates that the rider was killed in battle. With the horse in any of the above positions, the rider standing beside the horse indicates that the horse was also killed. These are part of the regulations of the positions of horses and riders in equestrian statues.



He won Grand Ch of Show & for this Kathleen Maestas sent me a gorgeous deep chestnut, black mane/tail/stockings Morgan. He is stretched & has no markings on his face. He is O.F. & was either a test color or test run (test color I believe)....and before anyone asks - NO he's not for sale - he is a prized possession with fond memories attached!" Doris Rau

And still more...."We feel that the bald face Morgan is not worth very much compared to a star face bay Morgan or even (wow!) a SOLID FACE bay Morgan! We recently traded our star face Morgan for a \$95.00 value, and he was not perfect! Right now, we have access to at least 3 bald face Morgans, ranging from \$60 to \$75. As to the value of a super rare solid face Morgan, the value would most likely be determined on how bad someone wanted it! To this date, we have seen 2 solid face bay Morgans, and actually (gasp!) traded one of them! They do exist!"






