Seral：Stock knoum to have been running urild for at least 100 years without introductions of outside blood；Fild Mustang

Bare：Cess than 200 registrations／yr；Tashkir Curly，Spanish Bark， Cleveland Bay．＂

Also．．．some interesting points on statues of horses and riders： $\mathcal{A}$ horse standing on all four legs with rider mounted designates the rider to be a＂INational Hero．＂凡 horse with three legs on the ground with rider mounted indicates that the rider died as a result of injuries suffered in battle．凡 horse with tuop legs an the ground and the rider mounted indicates that the rider was killed in battle． With the horse in any of the above positions，the rider standing beside the horse indicates that the horse was also killed．These are part of the regulations of the positions of horses and riders in equestrian statues．
