DON'T SNEEZE!! - by madeline

Have you ever worked with rabbit skins? If not, then this article is for all those with an odd sense of humor to try!! I'm not saying that this article has any humor, but I will sure try so that you won't turn the page! I came across this idea when my human was making covers for ten Peruvian Paso sets. So I asked her: "What would be a good source of fabric for this cover?" Something fuzzy and black (no, Laurie J., not THAT). Only thing that she could think of, that was anywhere near what she had in mind was rabbit. So she "ran" (er drive...its a half hour drive) over to Tandy Leather and picked up a couple of skins. The fur was actually a little too long but she thought she could fix that. At least both matched, and looked like it will do fine.

Okay, so let's go over this project step by step, giving [helpful] hints on how to get this stuff to work.

- 1. felt marker
- 2. scissors (although not really necessary)
- 3. razor blade
- 4. a large clean table
- 5. plastic cutting board, if available, and last but not least...
- 6. very important have a vacuum nearby. The canister type with a small attachment at the end. Good for house-cleaning, drapes, the cat, etc.

Lay out your skin (the skin of the rabbit, not your own), fuzzy side down. Watch where your "grain" is, because the fur tends to run down to the tail and then runs down toward the sides. Avoid any of the bad areas, like cowlicks as they will not make those pieces look nice, unless you like cowlicks (wet, sloppy licks from cows?) and think it would add a nice touch to your costume or project. In the sets that she was doing, it wouldn't look nice. Draw, or trace a pattern, with your felt pen, onto the skin. Take your blade (NOT the scissors) and cut down your lines, being very careful not to cut the fur, only the skin. Now the fun part. This is when she encountered a small problem: tons of unwanted hair (and it wasn't on her legs) all over her nice clean table. After cutting out all your pieces, you probably now have lots of loose fur just waiting for you to sneeze and get all over the place! So get out your handy dandy vacuum and suck up all that fur, even the loose fur on the pieces.

Be very careful not to suck up your piece of fur that you just cut up. My human did that once. Had to take the vacuum out to the trash can, empty out the bag to retrieve that piece of fur that she needed!! So glad it wasn't one of those "Rainbow" vacuums where it uses water! Oh bay, what fun, because not only were there dust, dirt, lint, and dead bugs in that bag, but lots of loose fur (also found a dog). AAAHHHCHOOOOO!! Go to the next piece and do each piece carefully and trim a little at a time. Do not rush, do not trim a lot at a time. You could end up with a lot of chunks. 





Here's last issue's question:

What's a "chalkie?" O: A:

The so-called "chalkies" were produced during the oil shortage of the 1970's, when Breyer began using "re-grind" (leftover Tenite) in response to the short supply of Tenite plastic. The re-grind was a colored plastic ranging from grey to green to red to purple. As such, any models requiring white markings had to be painted white first, thus giving them a "chalky" white look. "Chalky" models include: App Perf Horse, PAM/PAF in white and dapple grey, Rearing Stallion, Longhorn, ASB Weanling, APp Indian Pony, Spanish Fighting Bull (grey horns!), TWH, Justin Morgan, and TB Mare/Foal, to name a few. Also, the 99-piece run of dapple grey Hanoverians was also chalky; the models had already been painted bay, and were repainted white prior to being finished as dapple greys. One more note: the original 1970's chalkies do NOT remake well at all! The plastic is much less flexible than ordinary Tenite.

- O: What is the difference between the "Old Mold" PAM and today's? 2.

But never fear - some will be coming back in new colors.

NEW for 1990:

- 1. A bay blanket Grazing Mare with a Suckling leopard Appaloosa Foal
- 2. Three of the USET horses painted in bay to match REAL horses from the German Equestrian Team, and
- 3. A dozen Stablemates, some current and a few new colors.

Penney's is offering:

- 1. A set of three molds: bay Morganglanz, dark dapple grey Hanoverian, and a flea-bit Halla.
- 2. A set od six Little Bits all new colors I think!

Can't remember if we mentioned in the last issue about Your Horse Source having a sepcial run of Hartland models. Production limited to 400 pieces per color...Black Mustang, Dapple Grey Mustang, Golden Polo Pony, and a chestnut Polo Pony. When I (Heather) originally ordered the set when it first came out, the dapple grey Mustang was a semi-gloss finish - now they are matte finish - very different!

We've heard variations about the 1989 colors already: the Standing Pinto Stock Foal first came out with a white blaze - now there is no blaze on some models...found a dapple rose color PAF without the dappling - no lie - no little dappling spots! Check the packaged StableMate Swaps #5021 - instead of the chestnut, it's the black roaned color that is offered through the Sears Christmas set.
