And an article in a Quarter Horse journal showed the proper color markings to be used as a guide for registration--you guessed it, NO APPALOOSA-MARKINGS were shown. There is only one case I can name of an Appaloosa being "Honored" by being registered with the American Q.H. Society (?), and that horse was the famous "Joker B", and I think this is correct (I've NO new info--help!!). So, the letter writers were concerned about Appaloosa/Q.H. being shown as full-blooded in each breed class. What shall we do? Please write in some info to me!! Does it really matter in model shows, that a horse is shown in both? Do send in an opinion!! What do YOU, the READER, think??



THE OTHER CORNER

This month's question is, "What is a Hunter?" sent in by Margie Brunner.

A Hunter can be of almost any breed. One of the most popular breeds used as Hunters is the Thoroughbred. Many people who have tried a Thoroughbred-Quarter Horse cross have found them to be large enough to jump some of the most difficult jumps and also to have the calm disposition that often means the difference between following the hounds until they catch up to Reynard or going home after the first 5 miles because dear old Dobbin has sweated himself into a tizzy fit, and you'll have to walk him for the next two hours to cool him out!

To me, and to quite a few of the people that I've shown against (in real shows), a Hunter is a horse that has good conformation, no major faults, straight shoulders, etc. A Hunter is a horse which goes over jumps boldly and does not falter. He should like to jump. He SHOULD be a horse which is strong in wind, sound in bone, and, a horse you can handle safely.

Hope this helps!


