

I am cleaning up the study where I usually work in case my mother comes home. Therefore, I hope to get everybodies photos back to them.



#### PAINTS & PINTOS Flashers of the Horse World

Although the paint and pinto ( the names are synonymous) are often considered the underdogs of horsedom, they were often prized by both the Indians and the cowboys The Indians liked it because it had a natural camoflague (it didn't present a solid object in the desert), while the cowboys prized them because of their flashy color. They stood out in a crowd. Most registries, however, do not allow any spotted horses. For that reason, the pinto has often been relegated to the back of the farm for work only.

Other names used for pintos are: skewbald (brown & white-Britain and Eastern U.S.), Piebald (black and white), Calico Pony (western) and Ind Indian Pony. They also often have one or two blue eyes, also called china eyes, glass eyes, walleyes, cotton eyes, and watch eyes(one). Paitn originally was used to designate overo horses while pinto was used to designate tobiano horses, however, now the terms are used interchangably.

Two registries now exist for Pintos. One is the Pinto Horse Association which registers any pinto horse with good confirmation of whatever breed. The other is the Maerican Paint Horse Association


which i was created to create a specific type of spotted horse from Thoroughbred or Quarter Horse Stock. (Yellow Mount is one of the founding sires of this registry. It must be at least 14 hands and not be a gaited horse.

The two patternsfound in pintos are as follows:

Tobiano referre to a clean-cut pattern with delineated borders. Normal head markings. White dominates the dorsal or back area, dark covers the belly area. There may be a large dark spot or shield on the chest or front of th neck. They usually have brown eyes


Overo referrs to a ragged pattern. Legs and back are often dark colored while abdomen has white. Often face is white and blue eyes are common. Roan is also often seen as patches and in the mane and tail. Legs are often dark colored.
