H-R # A-266 CIRCUS PONY

This "head up" pony was made in glossy white only. He has a black mane & tail, and usually gold hoofs. The harness have 2 different styles. One is a straight design and the other one came in a scalloped design, this one being a newer design. The old ones carried a red plume on their heads. He stands 2½" at ear tips. He was produced from 1955 to 1957, re-re leased in 1930 in glossy white.

H-R # A-267 CIRCUS PONY

This "head down" pony is the mate to the above pony. Like A-266, this one also came in the glossy white, with black mane & tail, and gold hoofs. He also came with the red plume. He stands 1 3/4" at ear tips. He was made from 1955 to 1957, and re-released in 1980 in the glossy white.


H-R # A-297 ARABIAN HORSE


This in action Arabian prancing horse came in matt white & grey or glossy bay and stands 3½" at ear tips. He was produced from 1956 to 1959 and again in 1971. He also has a foal, he is listed below.

H-R # A-298 ARABIAN COLT

This is the foal to the Stallion listed above. He is VERY similar to A-048, the differences being; the tails. This foal has the tail held UP, A-048 has it's tail held straight out. This foal came in matt white and matt grey only. He was produced from 1956 to 1959 and again in 1971. He stands 2" at ear tips.








H-R # B706 CRUSADER

This Percheron drafter was made in white w/ grey shading only. He was produced from 1959 to 1960, and again in 1966-1967. He stands 6½" high.



H-R # B771 MODERN HORSE

This is the largest H-R known to be made. He is 13½" high, 1/2 " higher that the Nataf or Amer. OH. This mold was released in 1962 only and the color it was released in is unknown. The photo is of a plaster copy owned by Nancy Falzone.



H-R # B665 GIRL & FOAL

This lovely model was never put into production, why know body knows. It stood 9%" high at the foal's ear tips. It was designed in 1969.
