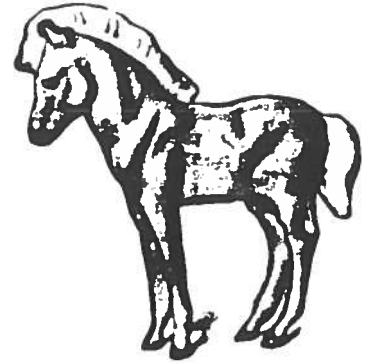
H-R # B562 SCAMPER

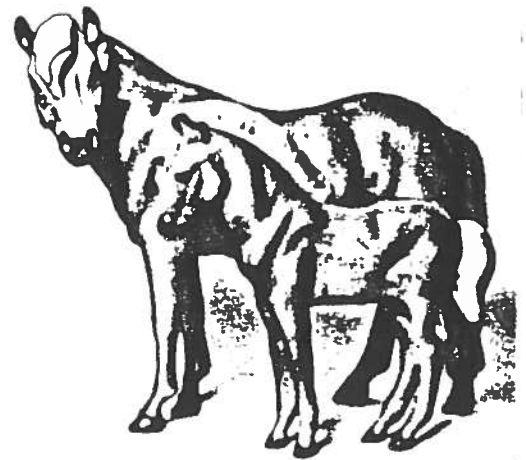
H-R # B564 RASCAL

Designer's Workshop Series, this Shetland Pony foal belongs to the parents below. He came in brown, grey pinto & glossy brown pinto. He stands 2 $\frac{3}{4}$ " at ear tips. He was made from 1954 to 1957 and again in 1967.



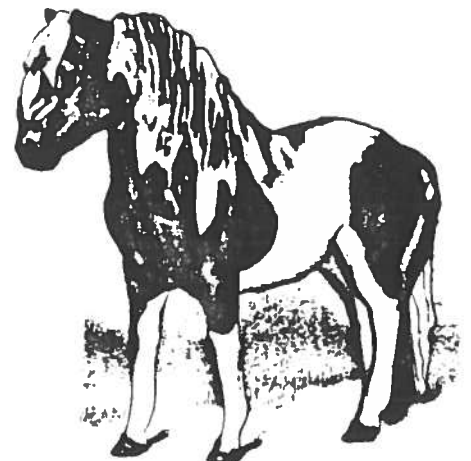
H-R # B565 MAYDEE

Designer's Workshop Series, this Shetland Mare standing behind her foal also came in brown, grey pinto, glossy brown pinto, plus rose grey & palomino. She stands 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " at ear tips and was made from 1954 to 1957 and again in 1967.



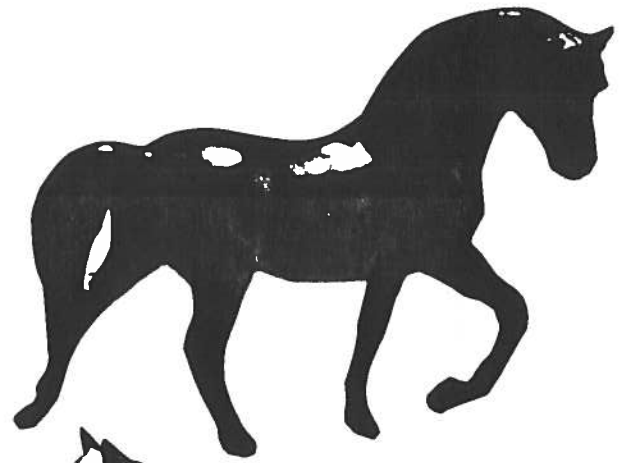
H-R # B566 WRANGLER

NOTE: the Pinto colorings of this family were only made from 1954 to 1957, all other colors were from 1967 release from what I have been told.



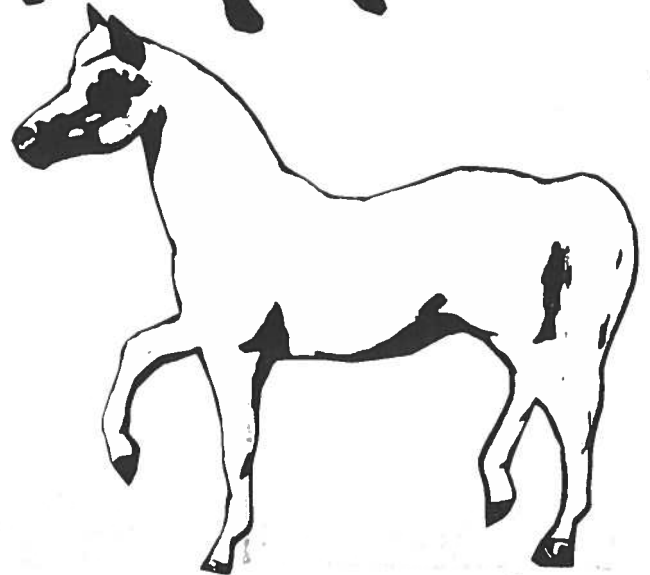
H-R # A-389 MORGAN STALLION

This lovely little stallion heads up this family of four. He was produced from 1959 to 1972 and came in brown and palomino. He is 2½" at ear tips.



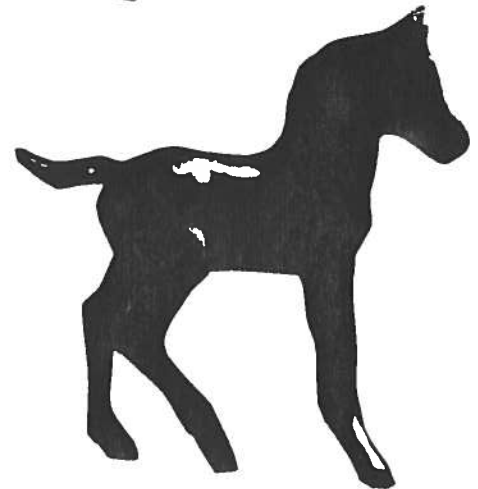
H-R # A-388 MORGAN MARE

This delicate little mare is a perfect mate for the above stallion. She was also produced from 1959 to 1972 and came in the brown and the palomino. She stands 3" at ear tips.



H-R # A-390 HEAD UP MORGAN FOAL

This is the first foal for this set. He like his parents was made from 1959 to 1972 and also came in brown and palomino. He stands only 2" at ear tips.



H-R # A 391 HEAD DOWN MORGAN FOAL

This is the last member of this family. He is the only one of this group not to be produced until 1972, he was dropped from the group in 1961. So he is a rare little one. He did come in the brown & the palomino, tho. He stands only 1 3/4" due to his head being down.
