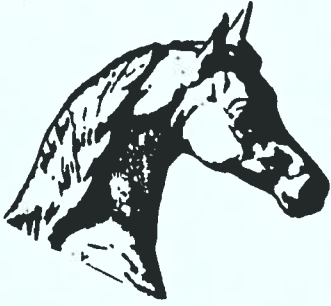

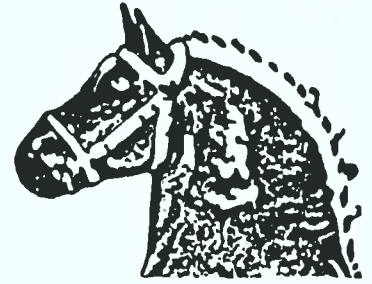

All are discounted colors and or molds. Bids accepted until December 15, 1984, at 9pm PST. No photos available.

When bidding, please state your bid in one of the following ways:

1. Straight Bid: I will bid \$xx on lot # 2.  
2. Will Go To Bid: I bid \$xx on lot #2 and will go to \$xx if necessary. (your bid will start at your stated figure & be raised \$1.00 at a time if another higher bid comes in under your "go to" bid & over your start bid.)

3. Alternate Bid: I bid \$xx on lot #2; if I'm overbid on lot #2, I bid the same amount on lot #2. (be sure to state clearly which is your first and which is your alternate bid.)

Weather mailing or phoning your bid, if you wish to be notified of a higher bid, please send an SASE. At close of auction, all successful bidders will be notified by mail. Payment must be received no later than 2 weeks after close of auction (dec. 31, 1984 deadline) or I must receive request for time payment by deadline or next highest bidder will be notified. Lot #1 B-771 Modern Horse, gold 13½" at ears. This mold was only produced in the fall of 1962 and came in gold or white. Semi-prancing pose with left hind forward & right foreleg raised. Right fore broken, repaired. Paint was discolored in areas by salt water, which gives it an antique look. Original H-R sticker on bottom of hoof. Can read "USA-Hagen". Minimum Bid: \$40.00

Lot #2 B-679 "Honora" American Saddlebred 8" at ears. Produced from spring 1958 to fall 1961. Matt white with grey mane/tail/hooves. Turquoise/Black ribbons. Eyes semi-tri-color, as a little brown is visible between white & black. Left ear repaired, small chip missing. Right hind break nearly invisible. Minimum Bid: \$50.00

Lot #3 A-048 Standing Arabian Colt. Produced from fall 1959 to fall 1972. Matt grey, black eyes. Left fore & hind legs broken, well repaired. Minimum Bid: \$20.00

Lot #4 A-236 Reclining Colt, left fore extended, right fore propped on ground. Produced fall 1954 to fall 1957, in matt white with black eyes. Left hind leg (underneath one) broken & well repaired. Minimum Bid: \$25.00

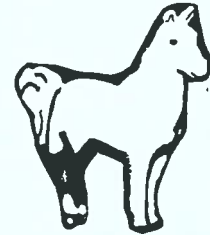
Lot #5 A-233 Standing (prancing or semi-rearing) horse. Produced in matt white, fall 1954 through fall 1957. All 4 legs broken, well repaired. Chips on right ear, neck under throatlatch. Eyes are black with eyeliner over pupil (looks like human eye). Minimum Bid: \$15.00

Lot #6 A-234 Rearing Horse, matt white, produced fall 1954 to fall 1960. Tail broken at base, well repaired. All 4 legs broken, repaired. Minimum Bid: \$20.00

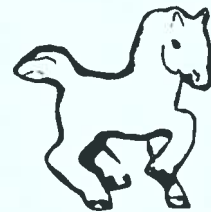
H-R # A-146 Saddlehorse

This is the Feet Together Saddlehorse, and he is one of 6 models that go to this set. He was produced from 1952 to 1954 and came in Bay & Palomino glossy finishes only. He stands 2 3/4" at ear tips. This whole set was designed by Tom Masterson.



H-R # A-147 Frisky Colt

This is another one in this set. He also came in either glossy Bay or glossy Palomino. He was made from 1951 to 1954 and stands 2" at ear tips.



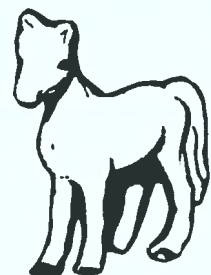
H-R # A-148 Standing Colt

Again this is another member of this set. Again he came in the Bay or Palomino colorings. He was made from 1952 to 1954 and stands 1 3/4" at ear tips.



H-R # A-169 Saddlehorse

Another member of this set, who also came in the same colorings, and was made from 1951 to 1952 only. He is 2 3/4" at ear tips. This mold looks similar to A-146, but front legs are not connected together.



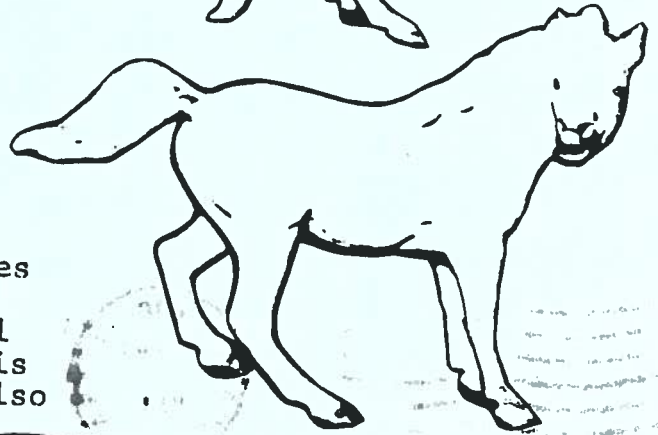
H-R # B-612 & B-648 FEZ

Both these numbers are correct for use on the FEZ rearing stallion. The 1st number issued was B-648 & then later they re-numbered him to B-612. This mold stands 7 3/4" high and come in Brown, white, palomino, grey & black. He was made from 1955-1957. He is much more finely detailed than the King Cortez rearing mold that is now released as a Mustang.



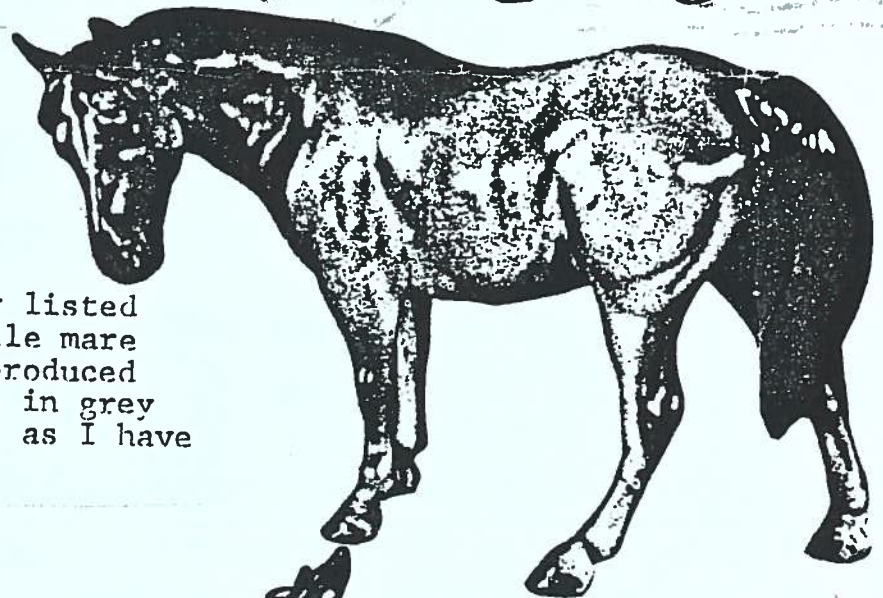
H-R # B-621 ABU-FARWA

This nice stallion was produced in white only from 1955 to 1957. He is 6" at ear tips and slightly resembles the Sun Cortez now released as a Mustang. Differences are ABU had all 4 feet flatly on the ground & head is turned back much further, tail is also higher.



H-R # B-626 Nancy

Here is the mother to Tony listed below. She is a sweet little mare standing 3 3/4". She was produced from 1955 to 1957 and came in grey and brown matt only as far as I have heard.



H-R # B-627 Tony

This little shakey legged new born foal is just right for his place with Nancy. He is 3 1/4" high and he also came in matt grey and brown. He was produced from 1955 to 1957.
