


H-R # B-679 Large Honora

This large version of the Saddler stands 8" high. She was first made in 1956 and was re-released from 1958 to 1961 and came in white w/grey shading, brown and bay. Some versions came w/ black/tourquoise ribbons and also light blue/white.



H-R # B-759 Small Honora

This is the smaller version of the Saddler, standing 6 3/4". She originally came in white, and brown. Ribbon colors of: green, blue, white or purple. She was made from 1962 to 1971. This is also the mold that was recently disc. by H-R.



H-R #B-705 Roan Lady

This is the only TWH H-R made. Originally she came in white w. grey shading and had tourquoise/black ribbons and was made from 1959 to 1960. She was again brought back in 1966-67 and in 1970-71 and came in roan w/ light green ribbons. She stands 7 1/4".




H-R # A-451 Mini Mini Stallion

This first member of this family is a proud little stallion. He was produced from 1958,1964-72 and again from 1976 to 1980. And is still availible today. He was made in white, buckskin, brown, and tan. He stands only 1½" at ear tips.



H-R # A-452 Mini Mini Mare

This second member of this family is the mare. She also came in the same colors as the stallion and was also produced in the same years. She stands 1 3/8" at ear tips.



H-R# A-453 Mini Mini Foal

This is the last member of this family, and the smallest horse H-R has ever made, standing only 1" at ear tips. As were his parents, he was also amde in the same coloring as them and was released in the same years.
