H-R # A234 REARING HORSE

This is one of 2 mini rearing horses H-R produced. This one is slightly smaller than the other one, standing $3\frac{1}{2}$ " at ear tips. He has a pony type look. He was produced from 1954 to 1960 and came in; bay, white, palomino, brown and buckskin in both matt and glossy finishes. Has been re-released by H-R in glossy dark brown.



H-R # A233 PRANCING MARE

This is the mare to the above stallion, she was produced from 1954 to 1957 and stands $2\frac{1}{2}$ " at ear tips. Her colors were bay, palomino and white, I don't believe she came in the brown or buckskin as did the Stallion. Finishes were matt or glossy. Has been re-released by H-R in glossy dun coloring.



H-R # A235 RUNNING COLT

This is the 1st foal of this family, a frisky colt. He stands 2" at ear tips. He was produced from 1954 to 1957 and came in the bay, palomino, or white finishes, matt or glossy.

Has been re-released by H-R in the glossy dun to match the mare.



H-R # A236 RECLINING COLT

This is the 2nd foal, a lying down one. He is $1\frac{1}{2}$ " at ear tips. He was made from 1954 to 1957 and came in the bay, palomino or white colors, both matt and glossy finishes.

Has been re-released by H-R in the glossy dun to match the above mare & foal.



H-R # B672 or B041 KING CORTEZ
(old) (new)

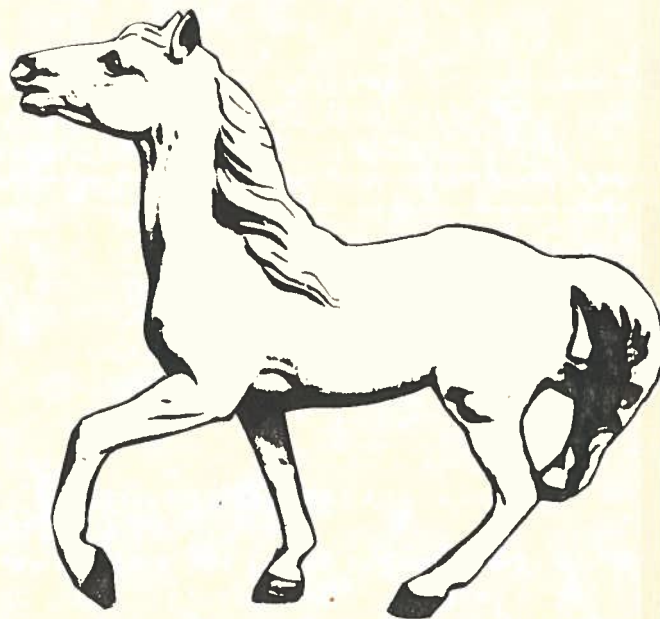
This is the first in this series of 3 Wild Horses. This is the rearing one standing 8" high. The old ones were made from 1956 to 1957 and came in white, palomino, brown & black. The re-released ones came out in 1981 to 1984 I believe. They came in grey, bay, white & black in both matt & glossy finishes.

Note the differences between this King Cortez mold and the Fez mold on oppsite page!



H-R # B673 or B039 DON CORTEZ

This second one of this series stands 6½" high, and is in a semi-rearing pose. The old ones were made from 1956 to 1959 and came in white, palomino, brown & black. The re-released ones came out in 1981 to 1984 in grey, bay, white & black in both finishes.



H-R # B674 or B040 SUN CORTEZ
(old) (new)

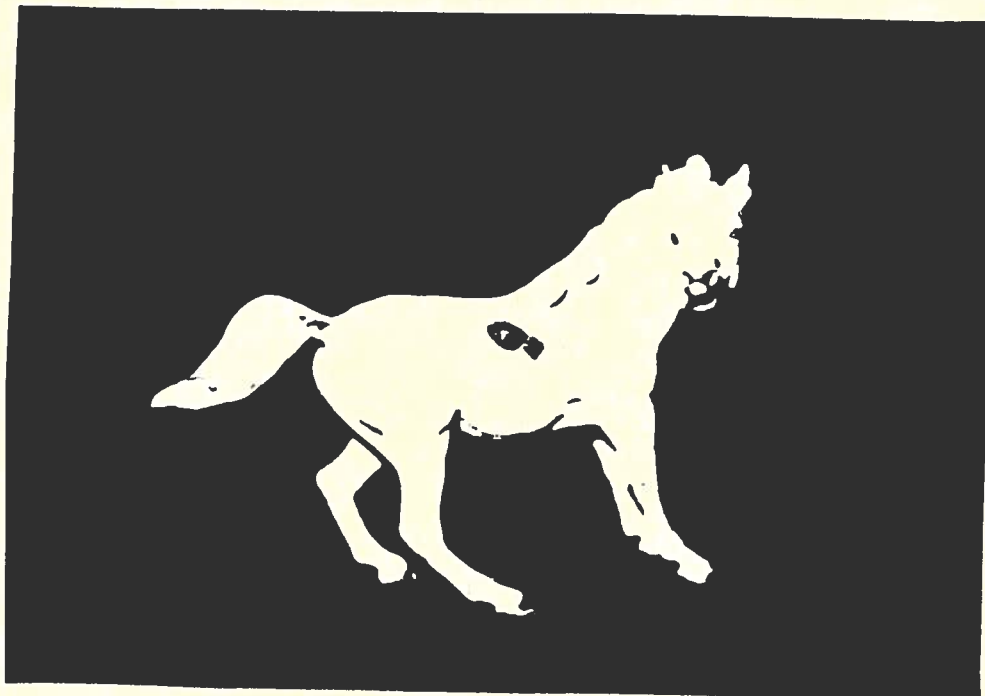
This is the last horse in this series of Wild Horses. This one is turning and stands 6" high. He was orig. made from 1956 to 1959 and came in the same colors as the other 2. He was also re-released in 1981 to 1984 in the colors discriber above. Note again the differences between this Sun Cortez mold and the Abu Fara mold!



When you register any of these molds, be sure which number you use is correct!



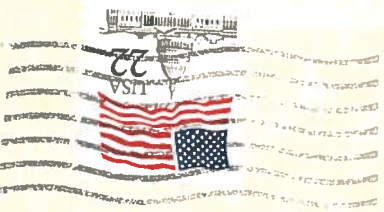
B672 King Cortez compared to B612 Fez
