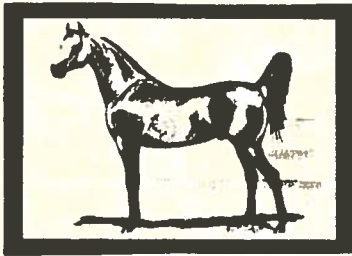

Also wish to welcome a new commmer to our club Karen Grimm, I wish her good luck in showing.

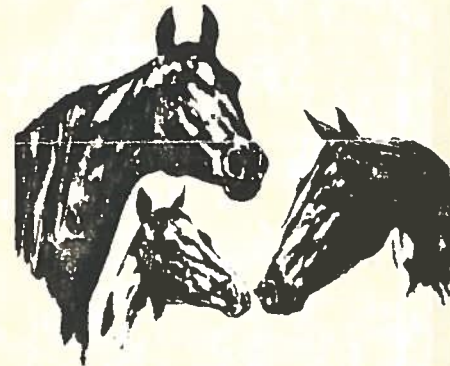

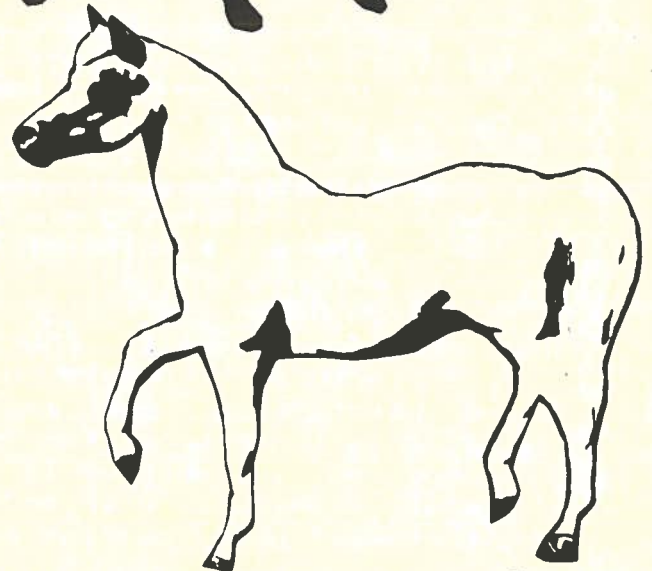
H-R # A-389 MORGAN STALLION

This is the first foal for this set. He like his parents was made from 1959 to 1972 and also came in brown and palomino. He stands only 2" at ear tips.



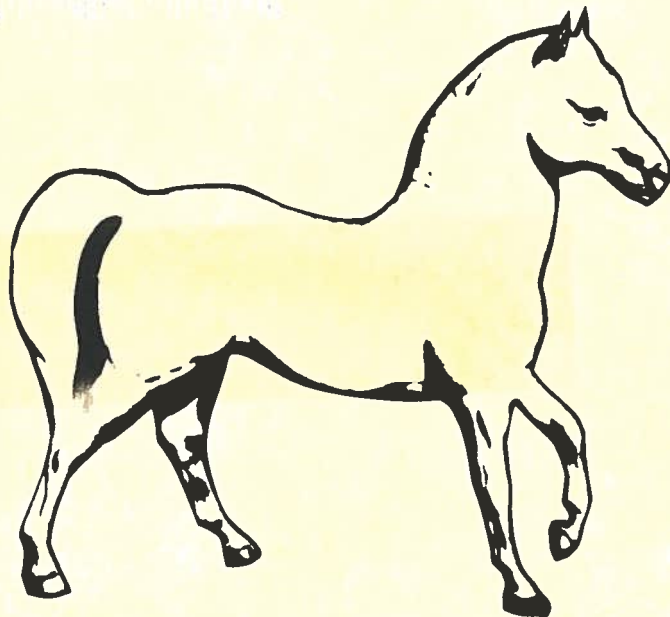
H-R # A 391 HEAD DOWN MORGAN FOAL

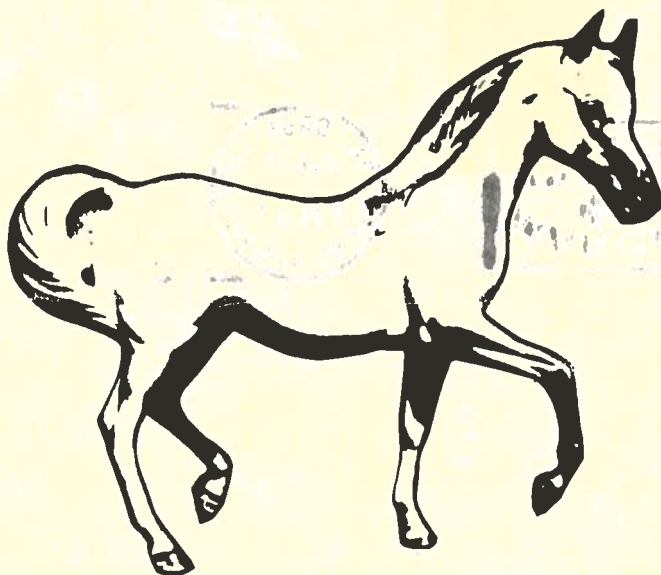

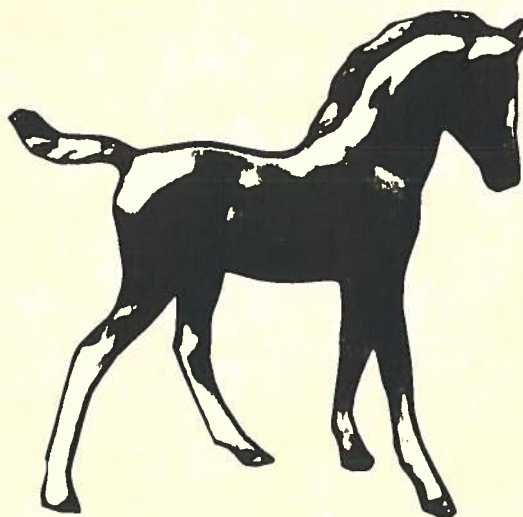
H-R # B-698 SHEBA

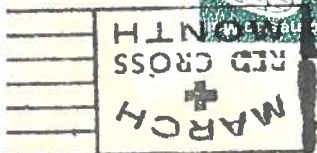
H-R # B-658 SHERIF
