Also, want to thank ALL of you who sent back the HRAC questionnaires, results of all questions are listed in this issue along with their resulations.

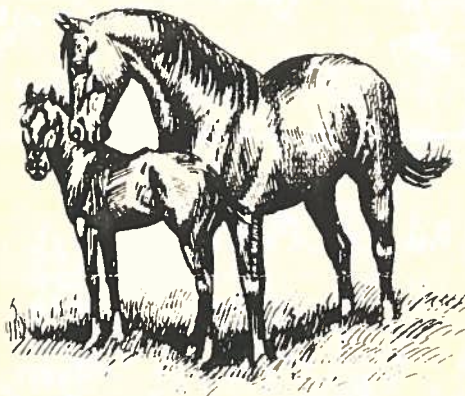

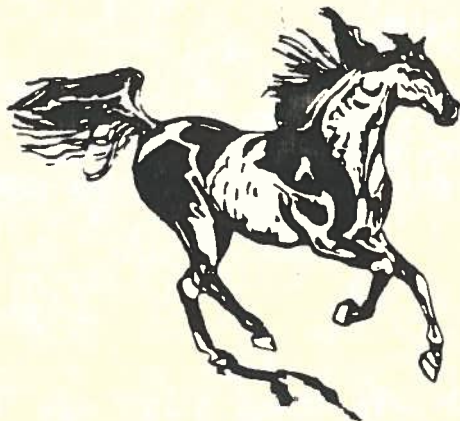

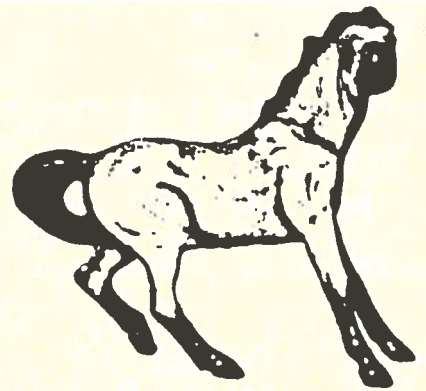

H-R # A360 MINI WILD HORSE

This little guy looks like a miniature Sun Cortez! He was made from 1958 to 1959 only. He came in brown or a buckskin, in both glossy & matt. He stands 2 3/4" high.



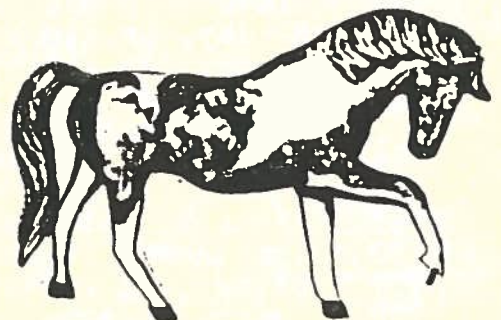
H-R # A428 STANDING HORSE

This QH type mold was produced in 1960 and again from 1964 to 1966. He came in palomino, buckskin and a black pinto. The pinto paint is a real problem, due to the fact that H-R DIDN'T bake on the spots!! So, take care when cleaning him. He is 3" tall.



H-R # A429 PRANCING HORSE

This is the mate to the above horse, and like the other one he came out in 1960 and again from 1964 to 1966. He also came in the palomino, buckskin and black pinto. Again care should be taken when cleaning the pinto as the spots weren't baked on! He is 2" at ear tips.



H-R # A480 REARING HORSE

This spirited little horse looks almost Arab, having finer detail and legs, than H-R #A234. This mold came in brown and palomino, and was made from 1961 to 1972. He stands 4" tall.



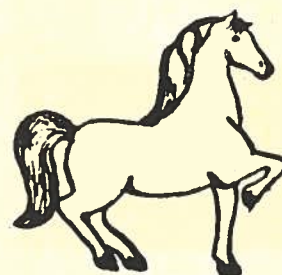
H-R # B535 REARING STALLION

Designer's Workshop Series, made in 1952 and 1953 ONLY! Designed by Tom Masterson. No photo can be found on this RARE gem, but I have seen one! He is in a rearing pose, (see sketch) and is about 5 to 6" in height. He came in Glossy Bay & Glossy Palomino only.



H-R # B536 HALF-REARING STALLION

Designer's Workshop Series, made in 1952 and 1953 ONLY! Again this mold was designed by Tom Masterson. He is the mate to B535. No photo can be found, but again I have seen this one and it's in a semi-rearing pose (see sketch) and is about 5 to 6" in height. This one also came in glossy Bay & Glossy Palomino only.



H-R # B537 HEAD-UP FILLY

Designer's Workshop Series, made in 1952 and 1953 ONLY. This head-up filly was designed by Tom Masterson and is only 3" at ear tips. She came in Glossy Bay & Glossy Palomino only.



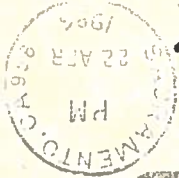
H-R # B538 HEAD-DOWN COLT

Designer's Workshop Series, made in 1952 and 1953 ONLY. This is the mate to the B537. This colt is head-down and was also designed by Tom Masterson. He is only 1 1/2" at ear tips, due to his head being lower. He came in Glossy Bay & Glossy Palomino only.
